

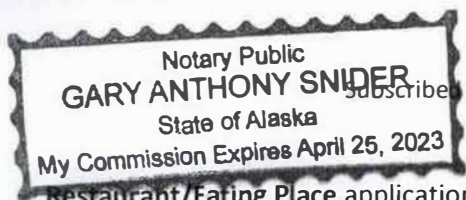

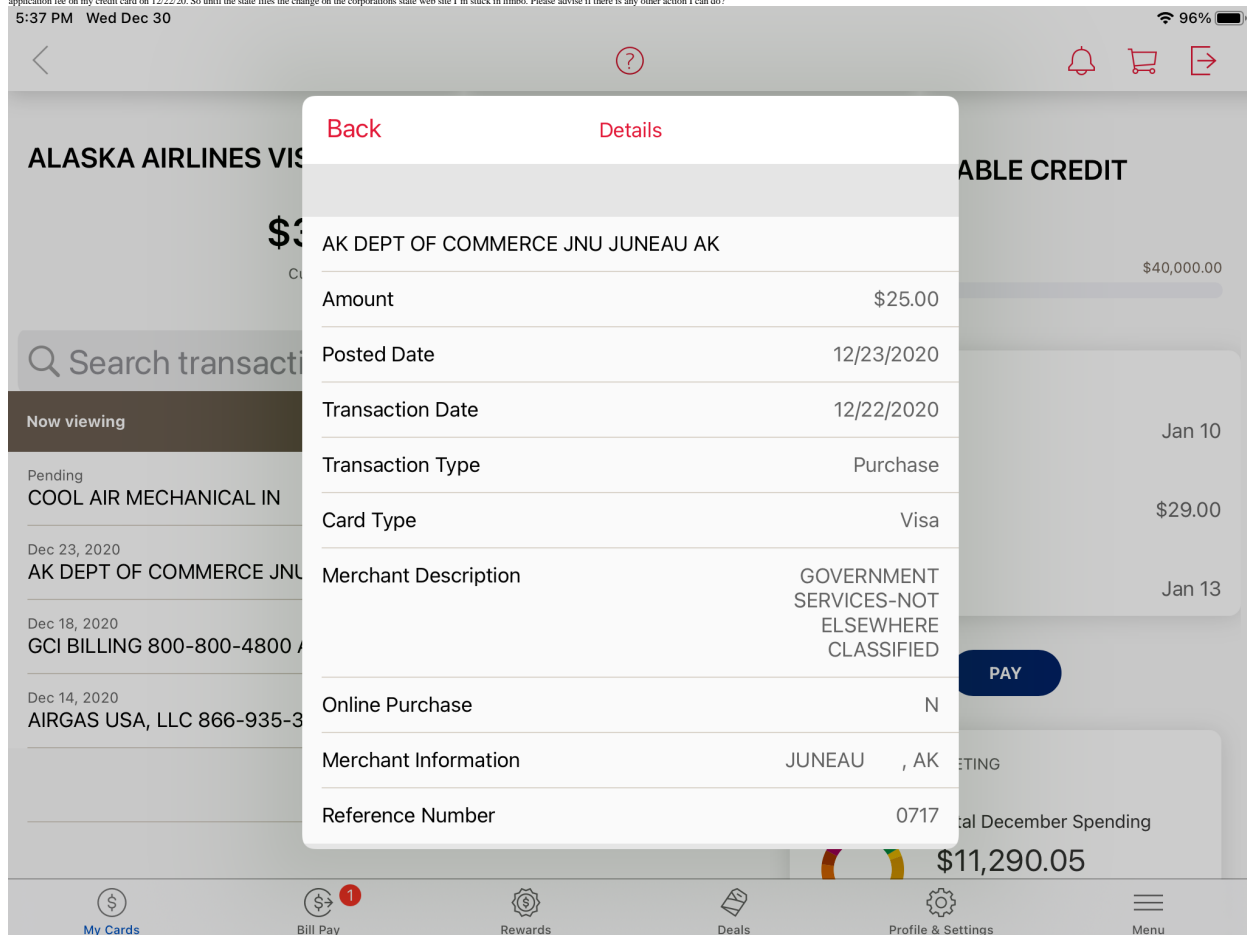

Good morning, Patrick.

- AB-01 statute reference would refer in this instance to the statute covering transfers. Assuming the type of company and type of license is not changing, you would enter AS 04.11.100
- Unless security interest is a part of the sale, you would put enter regular transfer
- You are correct that typically people get the paperwork, start the public notice, when public notice is done is when you then turn everything in, including that public notice piece. This is the time you would pay all of your transfer-related fees.
- Yes, the once a week for 3 weeks public notice rule remains in effect.
- Yes, that would push you past the 12/18/20. So you are correct that this transfer will not make the 1/5/21 meeting and instead will have to be on the next one at the end of March. As long as we get everything in and corrected before 12/31, this would be a situation where they would if necessary issue a temporary license in the interim.
- No, you do not personally notify the community council. That is part of my responsibilities.
- Yes, a grocery store or post office would make an acceptable conspicuous location.
- Please note, without looking at a completed transfer packet would I know for sure if your public notice is 100% correct. (In other words, verifying those percentages are correct, etc.) That said, here are my notes on the public notice based on currently available info: a) change Wets to West – otherwise yes, this looks good to go.
- The renewal fees are separate from transfer fees. Those should be paid when the renewal app is submitted.

Hello again, Patrick.

I am now officially confirming the report of change generally discussed earlier with myself and then fully reported with the renewal 11/13 is considered a transfer of controlling interest. Therefore, the requirements exceed the basic report of previously unreported change instructions I provided for you earlier this afternoon that will be associated with the renewal. This will require a full transfer application with mandatory board consideration, local government approval, etc. In other words: we will still need those 3 things mentioned in the first email. But there are other things now required in addition to that. Bottom line: renewal approval is contingent upon transfer application approval.

Instructions can be found here - <https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/Portals/0/sub/ahv/AlcoholLicenseApplicationForms/NewOrTransferLicenseInstructions.pdf> - you're going to want to follow that checklist as it will list off the additional documentation you must submit in addition to the application form packet- entity documents, fees(s), etc. Payment rules are the same as mentioned before: credit card form, check or there's the brand new web transaction system we're debuting 12/1.

That's the cut off for the renewal and transfer being considered at the next alcohol board meeting 1/5/21. But that date means (AMCO) boards the entire transfer application 100% complete, not just turned in. Otherwise, the next ABC board meeting is not until the end of **March 2021**. As it says on the site, please bear in mind -

Applying for a new or transfer liquor license is a long process, involving approval from the ABC Board, Local Government and other state agencies.

Applicants should plan for a 3 to 6 month application process.

AMCO Examiners have no authority to approve or expedite an application.

Please note that submitting your application by the published board deadline does not guarantee your submission will be presented at the next regularly scheduled board meeting. The volume of applications submitted, as well as the completeness of your application, will affect the length of time it takes for your application to be deemed complete and ready to be scheduled for board consideration.
