If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 7-9-20, AMCO Investigator Hamilton conducted a walk through of your establishment. The establishment was missing the \$1,500 civil penalty sign which should be posted at the entrance of the establishment. On 8-28-19 during an inspection, it was noted to move the existing civil penalty sign to the entrance. Also at the time of inspection the pregnancy sign and \$50,000 serving a minor sign was also provided.

As a reminder, not posting required sign-age could result in a \$100.00 a day fine.

Your attention is referred to AS 04.21.065: Posting of warning signs

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. Ms Hershock,

I am quite confident the person I spoke with last year misunderstood where the sign could go. I am a stickler about where this sign can be posted and inform everyone that the sign has to be seen as you are entering the establishment. Not above the door on the inside.

If I recall the sea bean as you enter there is a support post about maybe 15 feet into the premises. The service station is toward the back on the left. I would have told who I talked with that the two other signs could be put on or near the service counter and that the \$1500 sign could be posted on the post or window pane of door facing out or in one of the side windows. I do recall leaving two 1500 signs at an establishment to have them put one in the window on each side of the door.

Please remove the sign from its current location and place it so it can be seen as you enter the establishment.






