Requested Action:

Rescind the previous approval with delegation, hold an informal hearing and deny the application with 180-day abeyance period.

Statutory & Regulation Authority:

AS 04.11.510(b)(1): "if an application is denied, the notice of denial shall be furnished the applicant immediately in writing stating the reason for the denial in clear and concise language; the notice of denial must inform the applicant that the applicant is entitled to an informal conference with either the director or the board, and that, if not satisfied by the informal conference, the applicant is then entitled to a formal hearing conducted by the office of administrative hearings (AS 44.64.010); if the applicant requests a formal hearing, the office of administrative hearings shall adhere to AS 44.62.330 — 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedure Act); all interested persons may be heard at the hearing and unless waived by the applicant and the board, the formal hearing shall be held in the area for which the application is requested"

3 AAC 304.145(h) "The board may uphold a protest of an application or continued operation with a single abeyance period not to exceed 180 days if the local governing body indicates that the protest is subject to rescission and that it will be withdrawn if the applicant meets conditions set by the local governing body. If the local governing body notifies the board within the period of the abeyance that the protest has been removed, the application or continued operation is approved when all other applicable requirements have been met. If the local governing body has not notified the board within the period of the abeyance that it has removed the protest, the application or continued operation is denied. The period of abeyance may not be extended or renewed."

Background: At the August 17, 2021 ABC Board meeting, the Board approved the new license application with delegation. On August 25, 2021, the Municipality of Anchorage protested the application pending approval of a special land use permit by the Assembly and certification from Land Use Enforcement.

Staff Recommendation: Rescind previous approval and deny the application with 180-day abeyance.



Midnight Sun Brewing Co. Outdoor/Indoor Serving Security Plan

- All minors must be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
- 2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
- 3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs.
- 4. A second story deck with 42" railing is the outdoor servicing area.
- Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
- 6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
- 7. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside Midnight Sun Brewing Co. and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
- 8. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.
- 9. Keeping outdoor seating area viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol WILL continue to be a part of our training for our staff.
- 10. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
- 11. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
- 12. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
- 13. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
- 14. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.

Description of Non-contiguous Location

The non-contiguous warehouse building is 14,939 sq/ft according to the records of the Municipality of Anchorage. It is constructed of wood and steel framing with sheetrock interior and concrete slab floor through the space.

The non-contiguous premise at 8173 is secured with a 24 hour monitored security system with door alarms at every entrance and OH door opening. The security system also has motion detection monitors throughout the facility. The building is oriented in a North/South direction lengthwise. Starting from the Northwest corner, moving south 5 feet, there is 1 roll up door, 1 more feet south there is a roll up door, 8 feet south of that is two steel man doors, 38 feet south of that is a set of double glass doors. South of that by 10 feet is a dock high roll up door, 6 feet south of that door is another dock high roll up door. 40 feet south of that is two steel man doors. South of those doors 12 feet is a roll up door. On the south wall there is one steel man door 40 feet east of the southwest corner. On the east wall ther is one steel man door 80 feet from the south east corner, 60 fee north of that door is another steel man door. On the north wall there is one steel man door 60 feet west of the north east corner. All man doors are steel construction and have TTB approved deadbolt locks along with knob locks and are security wired. All roll up doors are steel construction, have a bolt lockin mechanism and are wired for security.

DSP storage has own entrance/exit, and separated from general premises by floor to ceiling wall, and from brewery premise by partition.
