

Tourism Statement:

The bar has upgraded it's point-of-sale system, and unveiled the largest projector screen to show films, documentaries and special event screenings, working in the downtown Juneau area. The hotel has upgraded its hardware and software, increased it's visibility across online search engines, regularly gets 5-10 times more views across all mobile devices than the closest competitor, and streamlined online and walk-in bookings both via the website and online travel agencies. Greatly improved customer relations by integrating 24-hour SMS text and voicemail.

Issuance of a liquor license at this establishment has encouraged tourism by allowing a centrally located, nationally registered historic site to be a window into the past, a unique and authentic bar and hotel. Alaska draws the fierce and the brave, adventurers who seek the higher ridge, hunters who hunt by moonlight alone, and when they come barreling down the mountain with a bear slung over their shoulder, they require a robust ale, no other bar will do, but the century-old, haunted bordello, the Alaskan.
