former licensee intends t	o use the potential reinstatemen	t to bolster the value of the property to in turn sell it			

and redistribute the profits to plaintiffs in a current lawsuit against Alaska Rendezvous Lodge (ARL). Mr. Mead alleges that the licenses have been in good standing since their inception in 2022. Historical memos show otherwise. In fact ARL has a documented history of nonresponse and lack of action when requested by AMCO staff. Below is attached the COMPLETE timeline of agency attempts to bring ARL into compliance by submitting the proper transfer documents. Please note that these transfer documents have yet still to be submitted to our offices nor were they referenced in the reinstatement and renewal request provided below.

Finally, the attorney for Alexandra Meiners cites the significance of these licenses to the Lodge as it pertains to the guest experience and their concern for the visitors to the Lodge being left in turn to bring their own beverages. This is in no way the responsibility of AMCO to prevent or mitigate and is further evidence that the former licensee and her representation may not appreciate the responsibility of an Alcoholic Beverage License holder to maintain the compliance with the licensing process. The location of ARL is Outside of City Limits and in and Unorganized Borough making it possible for any future owner/operators of this lodge able to apply for a new license through our offices through the petition process.

Please see the following timeline of events related to this subject.

<u>2.28.2017</u> AMCO 2017-2018 Renewal correspondence requesting transfers due to unapproved change of controlling interest ownership.

<u>2.7.2019</u> AMCO 2019-2020 Renewal correspondence requesting transfers OR reversion of ownership back to AMCO approved ownership with the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL).

2.14.2019 Licensee reverts controlling interest ownership in CBPL back to AMCO approved ownership.

<u>4.21.2021</u> AMCO 2021-22 Renewal correspondence regarding application corrections and possible transfer needed.

5.4.2021 Licensee changed controlling interest ownership in CBPL without board approval, which is a violation of AS 04.11.040(c).

5.14.2021 Licensee email to AMCO noticing of intent to submit transfer applications.

<u>5.19.2021</u> AMCO Renewals deemed complete and temporary licenses issued with request to licensee to submit required transfers within 30 days.

<u>7.9.2021</u> AMCO Records & Licensing Supervisor correspondence noting 30 days are lapsed and requesting transfers and giving additional time until close of business July 30, 2021.

7.19.2021 Licensee email response that transfers slipped through the crack and she is working on it.

<u>7.22.2021</u> Legal counsel for the licensee contacted AMCO and requested an additional extension to the July 30<sup>th</sup> deadline to begin the public posting and publication requirements. AMCO Records & Licensing Supervisor denied the extension request and encourage counsel to present their case to the Board at this meeting.

10.5.2021 Records & Licensing Supervisor correspondence checking in and offering assistance with transfer

<u>10.15.2021</u> AMCO Records & Licensing Supervisor correspondence notifying licensee of deadline for Nov 2nd Board meeting and again requested an update of the transfer statuses.

<u>3.16.2023</u> AMCO Records & Licensing Supervisor notified licensee of Expiration and Mandatory Cessation of Operation of both licenses #4270 and #4271 for failure to submit and application for renewal and payment of the required fees

<u>4.11.2023</u> Licensee emailed that she just found out the renewals were not done and asked for her options. AMCO Records & Licensing Supervisor advised that the licenses were expired for lack of renewal filing by the deadline and cited 3 AAC 304.160 for the reinstatement and renewal request process

<u>8.9.2023</u> Representation for Licensee provided renewal packets for both licenses AB-29 Waiver of Operation applications and the cover letter outlining their appeal for reinstatement and renewal.

#### Staff Recommendation:

With consideration to the history of the license consider if the reinstatement requests and license history for #4270 & #4271 meet the regulatory requirements.

We are assisting Alexandra Meiners and Alaska Rendezvous Lodge, Inc. (ARL) to seek reinstatement of ARL's two liquor licenses (#4270 & #4271) that expired in 2022. We also represent ARL in a lawsuit (*Rubin and Godel Capital v. ARL*, et al, 3-AN-21-5703 CI) filed in May 2021 by two purported creditors who provided ARL funds from 2003-2005. The lawsuit has taken over two years to reach terms for settlement. We are encouraged that in April 2023, the parties reached agreement whereby the underlying property would be marketed for sale and a portion of the proceeds would be distributed to the plaintiffs.

ARL's two liquor licenses are essential components of the lodge and heliskiing operation. They will also be essential components of the sale of the lodge. These licenses have been in good standing since the Alaska Rendezvous' inception in 2002 and there have never been any license violations or conduct raising any substantive operational concerns. We seek reinstatement of those licenses to continue to be integral pieces of the Alaska Rendezvous experience for the next chapter of the Lodge's future.

Theodore Meiners was ARL's founder and a heli skiing pioneer. He passed tragically in 2012. Since her father's death, Alexandra Meiners has served both as personal representative for the estate and head of operations for Alaska Rendezvous. She is now working diligently to ensure a successful transition for ARL.

Ultimately, the loss of these licenses will significantly impact the Rendezvous' ability to provide the exceptional level of experience and customer service to their clients that has made the Rendezvous a sought-after location for people who choose to visit Alaska. We are also concerned that it could result clients who are left to in turn bring their own alcoholic beverages in an uncontrolled environment.
