MEMORANDUM

TO: Alcoholic Beverage Control Board DATE: November 7, 2023

FROM: Kristina Serezhenkov, Regulations RE: Large Resort Endorsement. Specialist for Joan Wilson, Director

As described at the Board's last meeting, the Director noted that the large resort endorsement as authorized by statute was in conflict with AS 04.16.049, particularly regarding minors located at ingress and egress areas but potentially in other areas designated for alcoholic beverage consumption. The proposed regulation would apply AS 04.16.049(j) and permit the presence of minors in areas subject to the large resort endorsement if the minors are present for the purposes of travel, travel lodging, or outdoor recreation activities. It does so by defining an "outdoor recreation lodge" for purposes of AS 04.16.049(j) to include the holders of a large resort endorsement. Although "outdoor recreation lodge" is defined at AS 04.09.280(d), it is defined solely for purposes of that section, not AS 04.16. The attached regulations draft is for board discussion.

3 AAC 305.330 Endorsements available to beverage dispensary and beverage dispensary tourism licenses.

A new paragraph is added at 305.330(a)(3)(D) under large resort endorsements that, for the purposes of enforcement of AS 04.16.049(j) (Access of persons under the age of 21 to licensed premises.), allows a holder of a large resort endorsement to qualify as an outdoor recreation lodge.

Options for the board:

- Move to approve and send to Law for initial review and (with Law's approval) subsequent public comment
- Move to amend and then send to Law for initial review and (with Law's approval) subsequent public comment
- Move to send back to staff for more work
- Close the regulations project

 - (A) the endorsement permits the holder to sell or serve alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises, including in a dining room, banquet room, open air venue, and ingress or egress routes between those areas;
 - (B) the endorsement holder shall also apply for a multiple fixed counter endorsement to sell or serve alcoholic beverages from multiple locations within the large resort's property as set out under AS 04.09.440(c) (f); [AND]
 - (C) subject to the requirements for provision of alcoholic beverages by employees who are 21 and older as described under AS 04.09.440(g), the holder of the hotel and motel endorsement may stock alcoholic beverages in guest rooms for sale and consumption only in the guest room; and
