Requested action: New Recreational Site-Seasonal license.

Statutory and Regulatory Authority:

Sec. 04.11.210. Recreational site license.

- (a) The holder of a recreational site license may sell beer and wine at a recreational site during and one hour before and after a recreational event that is not a school event, for consumption on designated areas at the site.
- (b) The biennial fee for a recreational site license is \$800.
- (c) In this section, "recreational site" includes a location where baseball games, car races, hockey games, dog sled racing events, or curling matches are regularly held during a season.
- (d) The board may not deny an application for renewal of a license issued under this section or an application to transfer a license issued under this section to another person solely because the board determines that the licensed premises is not a "recreational site" as defined under (c) of this section if the applicant
 - 1. held a license under this section or received a transferred license under this section that was valid at any time between January 1, 2018, and March 31, 2019 or holds a license that was initially issued under (e) of this section; and
 - 2. operates the license under the same conditions required at the time of initial licensure.
- (e) The board may not deny an application for issuance of a new license under this section solely because the board determines that the licensed premises is not a "recreational site" as defined in (c) of this section if the applicant filed an application for a new license under this section between October 1, 2018, and the effective date of this Act [5/15/19].

AS 04.09.270(c) Sporting Activity or Event License (effective 1/2024): In this section, "sporting activity or event site" includes a location where baseball, hockey, rugby, soccer, or football games, car races, dog sled racing events, rodeos, skiing and snowboarding activities, bowling games or leagues, or curling matches are regularly held.

Staff Rec.: Review application for compliance with statutes and regulations.

Background: This application is for a new Recreational Site-Seasonal license in the Ketchikan Gateway Borough. Alcoholic beverages will be served for consumption in specific designated areas. Events include guided ATV tours taking place from May to October.



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

Outdoor Serving Security Plan for Adventure Karts

- 1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
- 2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
- 3. All staff are trained in the identification of fake IDs.
- 4. Entrance to serving area is gated (7' high by 10'2") and serving area is bordered by existing buildings.
 - Gate will be locked outside of service hours.
- 5. Underaged people will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
- 6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
- 7. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
- 8. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.
- 9. Keeping outdoor seating areas viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol WILL continue to be a part of our training for our staff.
- 10. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
- 11. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
- 12. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
- 13. Our top priority continues to provide safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
- 14. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.
- 15. Sale of alcohol will be limited to tour operating hours in accordance to KGB code and AS 04.11.210 (a)
 - The sale of alcohol will only happen after participation of tour. NO SALES BEFORE TOUR!
- 16. All garbage from alcohol sales will be removed properly (along with other garbage) to prevent bear activity in the courtyard.
