2.1 Explain how issuance of a liquor license at your establishment has/will keep encouraging tourism:

We continue to provide comfortable and pleasant lodging for overnight stays with great home style food and hospitality offered at our restaurant and bar. Our establishment has Alaska themes throughout with local artist's murals and Alaskan animals on display. We offer local Alaskan beers which highlight and helps promote other Alaskan businesses/breweries that visitors may want to see. We have scheduled tour busses that stop for lunch, drinks and a leg stretch in our beautiful rock garden on the premises. Tourists frequently take pictures of the garden and of our inside Alaskan animal display. They share these with family and friends which increases Alaska's exposure as a great place to come visit. We have space for RV's to park and information available for other places to see and things to do while visiting Alaska.

2.2 Explain how facility was or will be improved in accordance with this application:

Extensive upgrades were done in 2020 while closed during Covid. Summer 2021 brought many compliments for the upgrades. Bathroom remodels, new flooring throughout, new lighting and new windows to name a few. Our establishment was negatively impacted by limited access because of DOT Parks Hwy. expansion. DOT's project is close to complete with safer and easier access for all and making it better for RV's and busses to access our establishment also.

2.4 Description of dining facility:

Our dining facility is located in front of the motel in a separate building but easily accessible. The dining room can accommodate 50 customers or they can choose to dine in the separate bar area which accommodates the same. Guests can order a meal on site or to go. We offer American style home cooked meals with breakfast, lunch and dinner available.

2.5 Other amenities offered:

We offer information to our guests in our rooms with written material and in the restaurant/bar area for other activities, adventures and sightseeing. Our staff is knowledgeable of local sights to see and contacts for fishing and flying charters.
