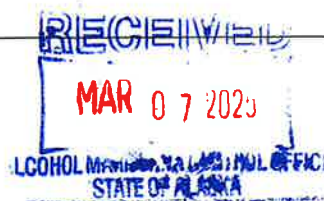

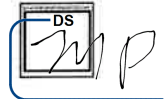

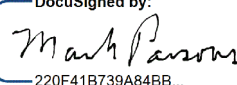

This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 06/07/2024 AMCO Investigator Linger entered Grand View Cafe & RV Campground to conduct a routine inspection. When asked to see the alcohol server card of owner, Mark Parsons, he was unable to produce one. A phone call to CHARR revealed his alcohol server card expired 08/20/2023. When his wife, Nancy Parsons was asked she presented an alcohol server card that expired 01/14/2024. Parsons stated he knew they needed the alcohol server cards to serve alcohol in their restaurant. Mark and Nancy were advised they could not serve alcohol without proof of current alcohol server education. This is two violations of the statute referenced below.

This is in violation of AS 04.21.025 Alcohol server education course (a)(c)

AS 04.21.025

(a) Except as provided under (e) and (f) of this section, as a condition of issuance or renewal of a license or conditional contractor's permit and selling alcoholic beverages under a license or conditional contractor's permit, the board shall require a licensee or permittee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages and a licensee's or permittee's agents and employees who sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification of a patron to complete an alcohol server education course approved by the board.

(c) A licensee, permittee, agent, or employee shall complete the course required under (a) of this section and pass a written test, online or in person, demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects not more than 30 days after being licensed, permitted, or employed. The course provider shall issue a card to each individual who completes the course and passes the written test. A card issued under this subsection is valid for three years from the date of issue. A licensee, permittee, agent, or employee may renew a card issued under this section; to renew the card, the licensee, permittee, agent, or employee must pass a written test demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects. Notwithstanding the 30-day period for completing the course and passing the written test under this subsection, a person may not sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification of a patron at a permitted event under AS 04.09.600 - 04.09.690 unless the person possesses a valid card issued before the event.

To whom it may concern;

With respect to notice of violation 3AAC 304.525, AMCO Case#:AM 24-1226.

Upon discovering that both of our TAP alcohol server cards had expired I immediately contacted CHARR and enrolled my wife Nancy in an online renewal review which she then followed by taking and passing the renewal examination online. CHARR issued a temporary TAP card good for 2 weeks. I doublechecked via email with AMCO that she could then resume serving alcohol at our business. The agent I was in touch with confirmed that would be fine.

I also enrolled myself in a certification class at CHARR in Anchorage for the following Tuesday, 6/11 which I completed along with passing the alcohol server certification exam. I was issued a new TAP card that day.

To prevent this from happening again Nancy and I are setting up a more formalized end of and beginning of season checklist. Reviewing our TAP expiration dates and associated timeline for renewal will be included in that along with the various other licensing and inspection requirements each year.

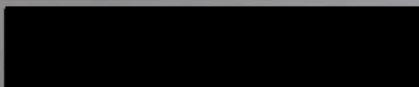

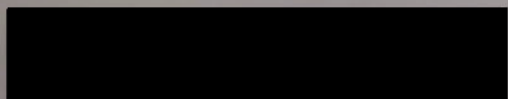
