MEMORANDUM

RE: At least 10 contiguous acres

Applicable Statute: AS 04.09.440. Large resort endorsement.

(a) A large resort endorsement authorizes the holder of a beverage dispensary license or a beverage dispensary tourism license that is a large resort to sell or serve alcoholic beverages from multiple locations on the resort property to guests for consumption in areas on the site of the large resort, including a dining room, banquet room, guest room, open air venue, and ingress or egress route between those areas. ...

(h) In this section, "large resort" means a resort that offers both outdoor recreational activities and overnight lodging to the public and is located on a site consisting of at least 10 contiguous acres containing one or more parcels of real property owned by the licensee or leased by the licensee, or a combination of parcels owned by the licensee and leased by the licensee.

Applicable Regulation: 3 AAC 305.330. Endorsements available to beverage dispensary and beverage dispensary tourism licenses.

(a) A beverage dispensary licensee or a beverage dispensary tourism licensee may hold the following endorsements: ...

(3) a large resort endorsement, if the licensee is a large resort as defined at AS 04.09.440(h), under this paragraph

(A) the endorsement permits the holder to sell or serve alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises, including in a dining room, banquet room, open air venue, and ingress or egress routes between those areas;

(B) the endorsement holder shall also apply for a multiple fixed counter endorsement to sell or serve alcoholic beverages from multiple locations within the large resort's property as set out under AS 04.09.440(c) - (f); and

(C) subject to the requirements for provision of alcoholic beverages by employees who are 21 and older as described under AS 04.09.440(g), the holder of the hotel and motel endorsement may stock alcoholic beverages in guest rooms for sale and consumption only in the guest room...

(b) For the purposes of this section,

(1) "contiguous" means having contact on all or most of one side.

(2) "adjacent" means next to or adjoining something else or having a common vertex and a common side.

The below touches on a few of the many requirements, etc. within the different endorsements. Please familiarize yourself with each of the endorsements outlined within this form.

AS 04.09.420. In addition to the fee under (b) of this section, the initial application fee for each fixed counter covered under the endorsement is \$1,250. An initial application for a **multiple fixed counter endorsement** must include an annotated drawing of the location of each fixed counter in the licensed premises.

AS 04.09.430. The holder of a beverage dispensary license or a beverage dispensary tourism license that is a **hotel**, **motel**, **resort**, **or similar business** premises that caters to the traveling public as a substantial part of its business may serve alcoholic beverages at a secondary location located in a building different than the licensed premises for the beverage dispensary license or a beverage dispensary tourism license if the different building. The holder of a hotel or motel endorsement shall exercise control over conduct of the business in all areas of the licensed premises.

AS 04.09.440. The holder of a large resort endorsement shall apply for a multiple fixed counter endorsement under AS 04.09.420 to sell or serve alcoholic beverages from multiple locations within the large resort's proper. For federal income tax purposes, the profit and loss from the licensed business conducted at locations on the resort under a large resort endorsement, other than guest rooms, must be combined or consolidated with the profit and loss from the licensed business conducted under the multiple fixed counter endorsement.

AS 04.09.500. The board may issue a **bowling alley endorsement** only if the concourse or lane areas of the bowling alley or both are (1) designated as part of the licensed premises for the beverage dispensary license or a beverage dispensary tourism license; and (2) adjacent to the main bar area.

AS 04.09.510. An application for a golf course endorsement must include a drawing of the golf course with an annotated illustration and a description of the portions of the course that are licensed premises and that are intended to be covered by the endorsement.

 information about the barriers, practices, and personnel that are to be used to ensure that alcohol is not
 introduced or removed from the permitted premises and to prevent the access of alcohol by a minor during the
 permitted event. A security plan may be requested for other proposed locations on a case-by-case basis.

I see that you answered to say:

Please see the attached diagrams that were submitted with my application last year 1/5/2024 ...our property is US survey 5576 lot 2-D & US Survey Lot 2-c , for a total of 9.34 acres. We

are a hotel/cafe in Denali National Park at Mile 224, our property (and immediate area around Carlo Creek) has many hiking area/trails. We have a pavilion/bbq area, corn hole and a campfire for guest recreation and enjoyment. Our guests come to stay at out lodge to visit Denali National Park and all the many activities.

Because your property has a total of 9.34 acres and not 10 contiguous acres, this will disqualify you for the large resort endorsement.

I can work on a refund for your large resort endorsement application for the endorsement fee, but because the application was examined, the application fee is not refundable. I have attached your receipt to this email as well as the refund request form. Please fill out the refund request form and send it back to me for processing.

Hi Jane - Thank you for following up on my application regarding the Large resort/multiple fixed counter endorsement, and your patience for my reply :) It has been a long process, and I'm excited about the possibly about putting this issue to bed, and streamlining the process from here on out for our property in Denali National Park. It will save time for ABC, myself and the (one) local sergeant in Healy who has to sign off on my caterers permits through out the summer for any special events we do.

In short, as we are nearly 10 acres... allowing us to have this new permit, will allow us to have the few events we do each summer (always one...the annual chili cook off in May we've done for 20+ years...and an occasional wedding or small group/business event in our pavilion), without the redundancy of filling the same form(s) for the same event, and trying to track down the one Sergeant (Minor) in the healy area to

sign off on our caterers permit (the permit request/diagram never changes). It is extremely difficult to do, and doesnt happen 1/2 the time (in Healy), leaving me scrambling or begging Fairbanks or your Anchorage office (in may 2024 I had to do this) to sign off.

Our main cafe, is about 20' from the pavilion on the creek and not connected. When we do have the chili cook off, we have a temporary portable bar that we set up for the event, and take down immediately afterwards. So there will be no permanent bar/alcohol serving area, only in our cafe. I hope that we can finally solve this issue with the new endorsement to alleviate this issue that we've been dealing with for many, many... years. Please see below in red for the answers to your questions, and please...please feel free to reach out to me at any time to clarify anything, as this approval is paramount to my emotional well being :)

We do not have a mini-bar in the rooms, and never will :) We do have an option when guests make a hotel reservation, they can order a six pack of alaska beers or a bottle of wine to be put in their cabin at arrival. All guests that make a reservation with us are over 21. Each morning if there is any requests, our manager delivers it to the room that morning before they check in that same day. If this is a problem, we can certainly not do it, we dont do very many requests and its just a common practice in nice hotels, and we like to offer it for our guests. I am completely transparent.
