RE: Meraki Afrah Restaurant Eating Place License 16590 – New License Application

This new license application was approved with delegation at the February 4, 2025, board meeting. The Municipality of Anchorage has since protested the new license application *"Protested until a Special Land Use Permit has been approved by the assembly and certifications from Land Use Enforcement, the Anchorage Health Department and the Anchorage Police Department have been received. -Per 3 AAC 305.085(d) the applicant was given the opportunity to defend their application by public hearing at the April 8, 2025 Assembly Meeting."*

Under 3 AAC 305.085(h) The board may uphold a protest of an application or continued operation with an initial abeyance period of not more than 180 days if the local governing body indicates that the protest is subject to rescission and that it will be withdrawn if the applicant meets conditions set by the local governing body. If the local governing body notifies the board within the period of the abeyance that the protest has been removed, the application or continued operation will be approved when all other applicable requirements have been met. If the local governing body has not notified the board within the period of the abeyance that the local governing body has removed the protest, the application or continued operation is denied.

If the protest is not a conditional protest, then other rules apply and... the board shall deny the application or continued operation unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, or unreasonable – AS 04.11.480
