I am writing in response to AMCO Case #24-1198 created after an inspection at my establishment, Kodiak Rendezvous, Inc., on June 4, 2024. (License #/Type: 2639- Beverage Dispensary)

Ms. Krysta Starr was cited for not having a current TAP card present while working. Only an expired card was on site at the time of the inspection.

I have now reviewed with each employee the status of their TAP card, made sure it is either kept at the Rendezvous or that each employee understands it must be with them at all times while working. Each employee is now aware of their expiration date and knows they must renew prior to this date.

I have been provided proof that Krysta completed the server education course offered online as of June 8, 2024.

I feel confident that there will be no further issues related to this type of violation.

This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

**Note:** This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 6-4-24 an inspection was conducted at your establishment. Bartender Krysta Joy Starr was asked to provide proof of current server education. Ms. Starr present TAP Card #180980, expiring 11-3-23. Ms. Starr was told to stop serving alcoholic beverages until she could provide an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board representative proof of current server education. Ms. Starr was issued a citation.

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
