Objective

To prevent the unauthorized transfer of alcohol across the licensed premises boundary and ensure minors do not gain access to alcoholic beverages, in compliance with Alaska statutes and ABC Board requirements.

1. Personnel

A. Staff Training

- All staff serving alcohol must complete the **Alcohol Server Education Course (TAPS or equivalent)** as required by the State of Alaska.
 - Staff trained to:
 - Recognize valid and fake IDs.
 - Identify signs of intoxication and underage drinking.
 - Intervene appropriately if someone attempts to pass alcohol to a minor or remove it from the premises.

2. Physical Barriers & Premises Control

A. Entrances & Exits

- All public access points will be monitored during open hours.
- Use of controlled entry points into locations where alcohol can be purchased.
- Signage warning of unaccompanied persons under 21 posted outside of any location serving alcohol per AS 04.21.065.

B. Perimeter

- Fencing or physical barriers will mark the boundary of licensed premises.

- Surveillance cameras covering all boundary areas to deter and record any attempt to smuggle alcohol off-site.

C. Internal Controls

- Alcohol service areas clearly marked and separated from non-service areas.
 - Minors restricted from bar/service areas unless accompanied by a guardian, if legally permissible.
 - Use of wristbands or hand stamps to identify 21+ patrons for mixed-age events.
-

3. Operational Practices

A. ID Verification

- Mandatory ID checks for all patrons purchasing or consuming alcohol.
- Acceptable IDs:
 - State-issued driver's license or ID card.
 - U.S. Passport or passport card.
 - Military ID.
 - Tribal ID recognized by the State of Alaska.

B. Alcohol Management

- Alcohol may only be served and consumed within the licensed boundary.
 - No "to-go" alcohol unless legally permitted (sealed container laws).
 - Bartenders and servers instructed to report any suspicious behavior, especially transfer attempts.
 - Alcohol can only be delivered to any room requesting room service by a TAPS certified employee. No open containers can be taken to rooms by guests.
 - Guests cannot walk around the property with open containers. Guests must consume within the designated areas or within their room rental or directly in front of their cabin.

4. Compliance & Monitoring

A. Coordination with Law Enforcement

- Cooperate with local law enforcement and AMCO investigators.
- Invite periodic inspections to ensure adherence.

B. Internal Audits

- Monthly reviews of surveillance footage and incident logs.
- Ongoing staff refresher training sessions every 6 months.

C. Reporting

- All alcohol-related incidents involving minors or attempted smuggling reported to the Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) as required.

Conclusion

This security plan is designed to protect our patrons and community by preventing underage access to alcohol and unauthorized removal of alcohol from our premises. Through well-trained personnel, strict operational controls, and physical boundaries, we aim to fully comply with Alaska laws and promote a safe and lawful environment.

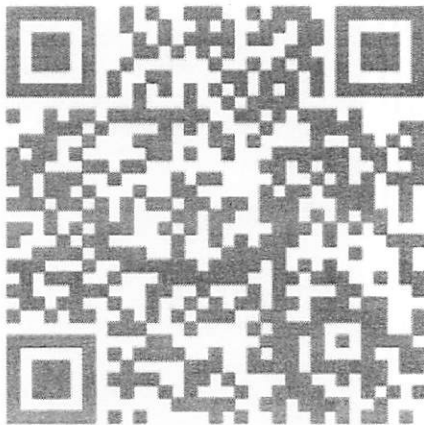
