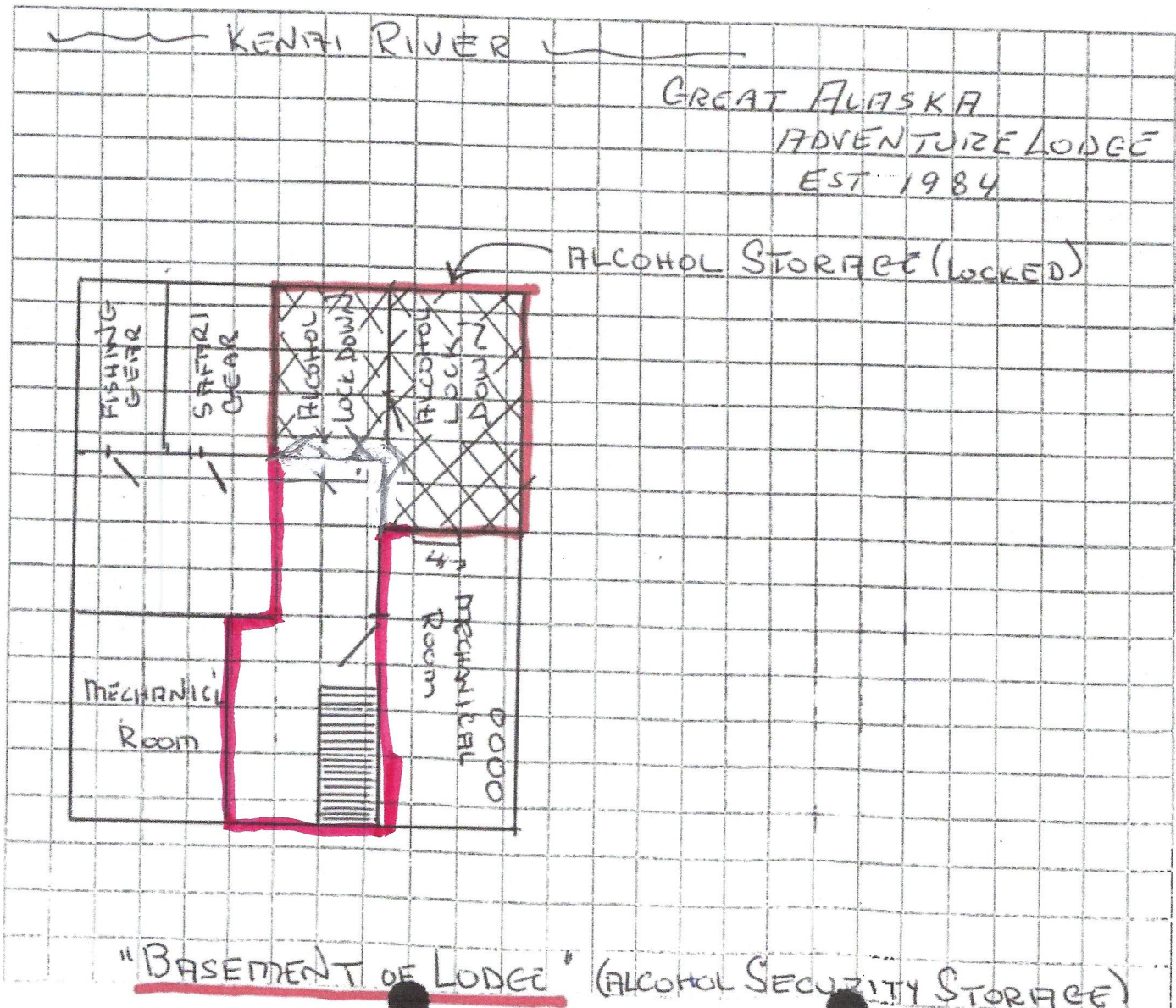

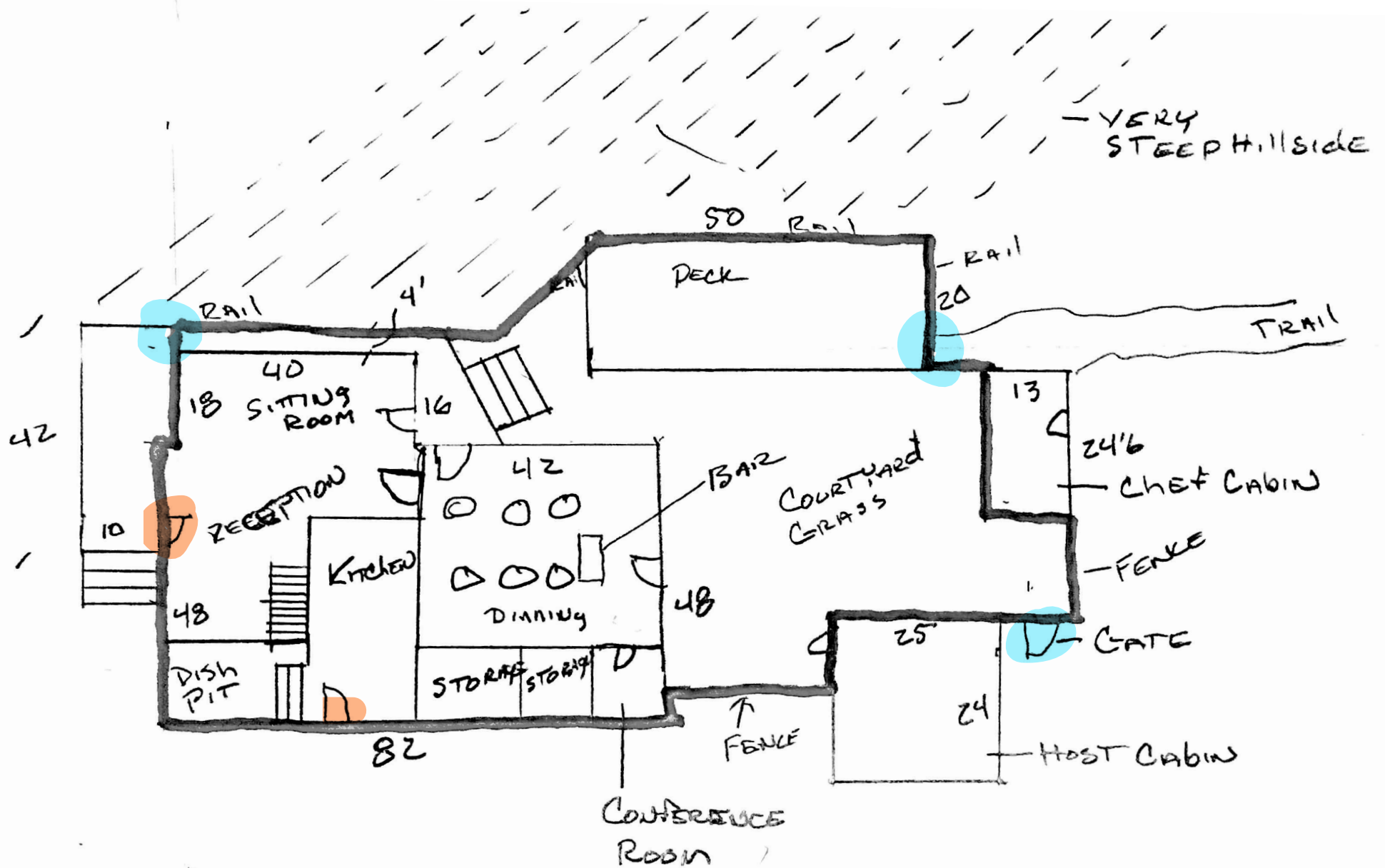

1. All minors will be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
2. All new patrons are carded upon Check-in to the lodge.
3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs. All employees serving alcohol will have a Tap card.
4. A six foot Fence and exterior cabin walls surround the east and south side. There is one gate through the fence in the south east corner. The rail along the north side is 42 inches and the deck has rail and glass around the outside edges at 44 inches. The rest of the area is exterior walls of the building.
5. Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
7. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside Great Alaska Lodge and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
8. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.
9. Keeping outdoor seating area viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol WILL continue to be a part of our training for our staff.
10. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
11. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
12. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
13. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.
