





 - Dimensions (AMCO does not accept diagrams drawn to scale)
 - Cross streets
 - Points of reference, such as a compass rose indicating True North
 - All entrances, exits, walls, bars, and fixtures

 - You must identify the stairs between each floor, and each hallway/corridor that leads to each set of stairs.






Indoor Serving Security Plan

1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs.
4. Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
5. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
6. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside (BUSINESS) and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
7. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
8. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
9. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
10. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.

Describe how the location will be secured?

The storage unit is a 20 foot metal connex that will sit on the property of the distillery. Connexes have double metal doors on both ends and can be padlocked in two places at each door. The locking mechanism is thick steel and allows for very robust padlocks. Inside the connex any alcohol will be stored in either plastic barrels or stainless steel tanks. Shelving along the sides will provide additional storage for supplies and grain.
The back of the distillery where the connex is located will have motion sensor lights and video cameras.
