Dear Members of the Marijuana Control Board:

I am writing to express my strong support of the proposed Amendment to 3 AAC 306.370(e)(1) regarding the isolation and physical separation requirements for edibles-only onsite consumption (OSC) areas within retail marijuana stores.

This regulation change addresses consumer safety and operational efficiency by removing the requirement that edibles-only OSC areas be isolated and physically separated from other areas of the licensed premises. I am glad that the MCB recognizes key distinctions between consumption types and provides greater flexibility for marijuana retail stores to optimize their space.

Customers who smoke/vape marijuana on-site need to be in a separately ventilated area, as only smoking/vaping marijuana involves airborne particles that must be adequately ventilated. Allowing edibles-only consumption areas to be within retail stores licensed premises maintains the separation of smoking/vaping areas while acknowledging that edibles do not carry the same public health risks as smoking or vaping.

This Amendment will give retail marijuana stores flexibility in layout and design. Allowing edibles-only consumption areas to exist within the retail licensed premises would allow businesses to be creative and unique in style and design without compromising compliant business operations and causing extensive and unnecessary renovations. Instead of requiring customers who prefer edibles to go to a separate, isolated part of the store where there will be smoke and vape particles in the air, businesses can create a more inviting environment for their customers. This Amendment will help Alaska's marijuana industry remain competitive and appealing to both Alaskans and tourists.

To conclude, I advocate for and encourage MCB to adopt the proposed Amendment to 3 AAC 306.370(e)(1). This Amendment balances public health concerns with the operational realities of the Alaska Marijuana industry, supporting both consumer choice and industry growth. We appreciate MCB's efforts to continuously refine Alaska's marijuana regulations to encourage a safe market.

Re: Comment on MCB proposed changes to regulations in Title 3, Chapter 306 section 370(e)(1) of the Alaska Administrative Code.

The Alaska Marijuana Industry Association (AMIA) supports amending the requirements for onsite consumption of marijuana products. The proposed changes prioritize public health and safety by addressing critical issues, such as retailers observing customers leaving licensed premises and consuming edibles in public view, which poses risks to both public health and safety. The amendments also focus on providing a safe and accessible space for visitors to legally consume.

The amended regulations reflect best practices for consumer safety. Visitors to Alaska typically aim to comply with local laws, and a key reason the Marijuana Control Board established onsite consumption was to provide legal venues for these visitors. However, current requirements for onsite consumption lounges, such as the need for separate rooms, hinder the accessibility intended for out-of-state visitors to consume legally. Additionally, these requirements impose unnecessary costs and burdens on licensees who wish to offer a legal setting for edible consumption. **Since edibles do not require ventilation, separate rooms are unnecessary and can obstruct effective monitoring by staff.** Removing these barriers will enhance public safety by allowing better observation of consumer behavior.

The AMIA thanks the Marijuana Control Board for trusting licensees and employees by expanding regulations in a way that supports both commerce and public health and safety. We believe that the AMIA, the Marijuana Control Board, and the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office share a common goal: to evolve regulations that best support commerce within the State of Alaska. We appreciate the opportunity to provide feedback and guidance from an industry perspective in this ongoing effort.
