In February of 2021, the Governor's emergency regulations regarding the service of alcoholic beverages expired. In addition, on 4-14-21, 3 AAC 304.465 was amended to allow for any **approved** alcohol server course providers to instruct via internet-based webinar or video teleconference to anyone in the state.

To date, the following courses are approved for obtaining Alaska alcohol serving training:

TIPS (360 Training) has agreed to waive their in-person course fee for those who are affected by this notice.
