RE: Enforcement Report, Marijuana

AMCO Enforcement has hired Nathan Bryson to fill the vacant Special Investigator I position in Anchorage. Investigator Bryson is a United States Marine Corps veteran and has over 6 years of law enforcement experience in Ohio and Alaska, most recently with the Nome Police Department. He attended the Tri-C Police Academy in Cleveland, Ohio as well as the Alaska Department of Public Safety Recertification Academy.

Pursuant to AS 04.06.110 and AS 17.38.131, I am requesting that you grant Investigator Bryson the authority to exercise Peace Officer powers at such time as concurrence is received from the Department of Public Safety.

In addition, pursuant to 3 AAC 304.505(b), I am requesting your approval for Investigator Bryson to carry a firearm in the performance of his duties.

Investigator Whiteman is leaving State service on April 17th, 2026. We would like to thank him for 10 years of service to the State of Alaska. A recruitment waiver will be submitted to fill the vacancy as soon as possible.

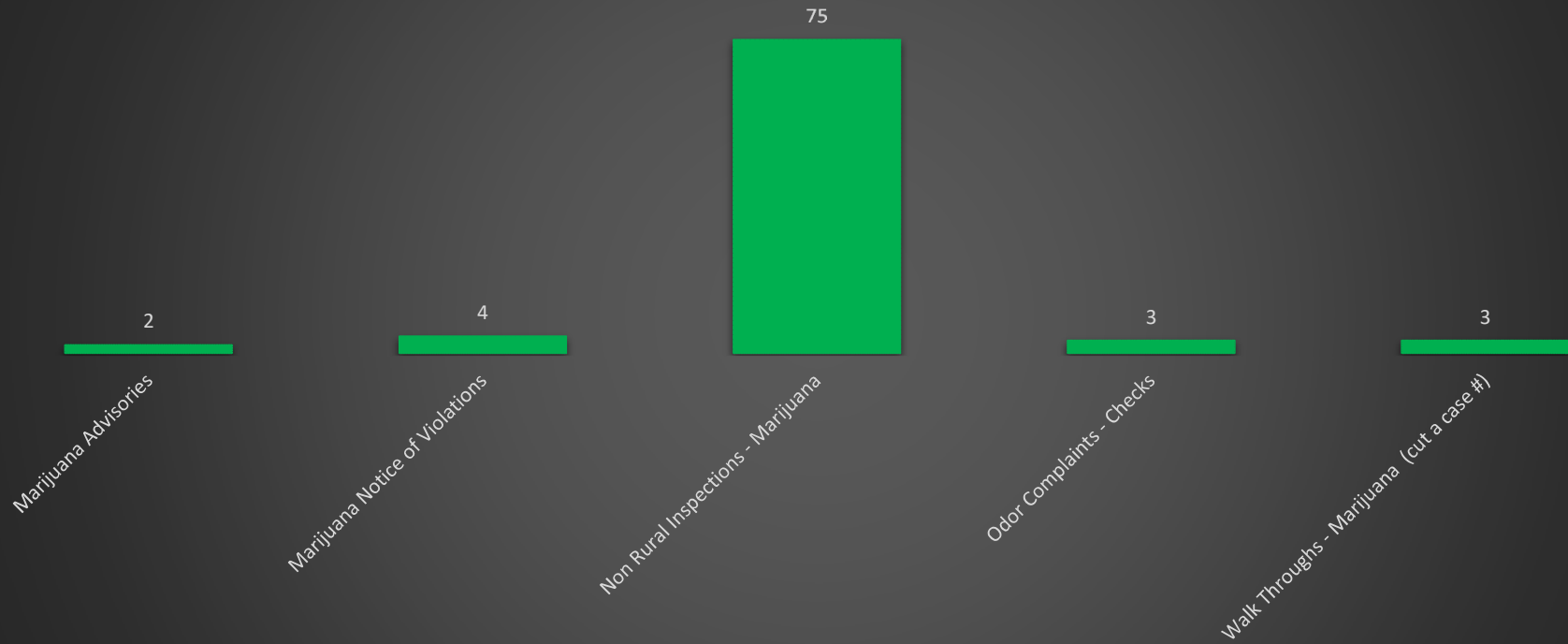
The recruitment waiver for the vacant Fairbanks Special Investigator I position was recently approved and will be posted shortly. Director Richard and I are continuing to evaluate the potential reclassification of one or more existing Special Investigator vacancies to the Investigator series to attract a larger pool of qualified applicants.

AMCO Enforcement has continued to conduct inspections of both alcohol and marijuana in a consistent and steady manner.

MCB Enforcement Principles



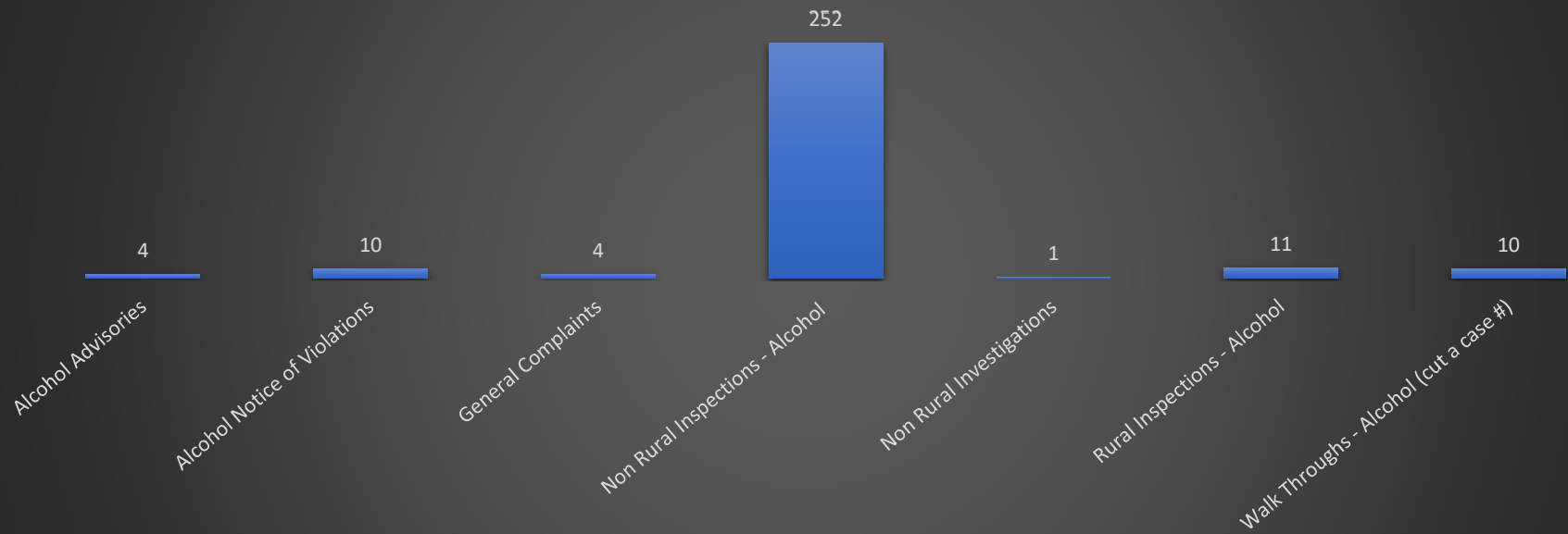
