RE: 2026-2027 Marijuana Establishment License Renewal Application Notice

Dear Licensee,

Your marijuana establishment license is due for renewal. No later than **June 30, 2026**, the complete electronic renewal application, corresponding fees, and supplemental documents must be submitted to the Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office (AMCO), as required under 3 AAC 306.035. Corporations and limited liability organizations that applying for renewal must also be in good standing with the Division of Corporations for the renewal application to be considered complete.

The following documents and items must be submitted for all license types:

- **Online Renewal Application**
- **Form MJ-20: Renewal Application Certifications**
- **Form MJ-20a: Residency Exception Affidavit (if applicable)**
- **Fingerprint Cards must be accompanied by a MJ Authorization of Records Release Form** (one for each individual licensee **who is not on the background check list**)
 - **Fingerprint Fees** (\$47.00 per person)
 - **If you have multiple marijuana licenses being renewed, one fingerprint card and fee for each individual licensee will suffice for all marijuana licenses being renewed.**

RENEWAL APPLICATION FEES

- **Renewal Application Fee: \$600.00**
- **License Renewal Fee:**
 - Limited Cultivation: \$1,000.00
 - Concentrate Manufacturing: \$1,000.00
 - Testing Facilities: \$1,000.00
 - Standard Product Manufacturing, Retail Store, and Standard Cultivation: \$5,000.00
- **Onsite Consumption Endorsement Renewal Application Fee (if applicable): \$600.00 (this is in addition to the renewal application fee)**
- **Onsite Endorsement Renewal Fee (if applicable): \$2,000.00 (this is in addition to the renewal application fee and the onsite consumption endorsement renewal application fee)**

AN APPLICATION WILL BE CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE UNLESS AND UNTIL ALL REQUIRED SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN ACCURATELY COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED, AND ALL REQUIRED FEES HAVE BEEN PAID.

We accept personal or bank checks, cashiers' checks, money orders (confirm money orders are signed, and address is filled to avoid an invalid payment), credit cards, e-bill (we send you an electronic bill), and cash through Department of Revenue's Drop Box, only (do not present cash at AMCO's counter). **Payment (some sort of confirmation of payment submitted, in the case of cash, to DOR) for all fees must be received in our AMCO's Anchorage office no later than June 30, 2026.**

Any application that is submitted or incomplete after June 30, 2026, is delinquent and will be assessed an additional non-refundable \$1,000 late renewal application fee under 3 AAC 306.100(b).

Any marijuana establishment that fails to submit a complete license renewal application on or before August 31, 2026, for any reason, including failure to pay any required fees or submit accurate and complete copies of any required supplemental documents, will have its corresponding license expire at 11:59 pm on August 31, 2026. Any holder of an expired license must immediately surrender the license to AMCO. If you do not intend to seek a renewal of your license, please send a written notification to AMCO staff by emailing marijuana.licensing@alaska.gov.

The Marijuana Control Board (MCB) will decide whether to grant or deny an application not later than 90 days after receiving the complete application. The MCB may hold a hearing under 3 AAC 306.070 to ascertain the reaction of the public or a local government to any complete application, either on its own initiative or in response to an objection or protest received under 3 AAC 306.060 or 3 AAC 306.065 respectively. If the MCB approves your renewal application, your 2025/2026 marijuana establishment license will be delivered to you by an AMCO investigator or mailed to you at the mailing address on file.

Please scan and email complete supplemental documents (with the exception of payment and fingerprint cards) and send any questions or concerns about your renewal application to marijuana.licensing@alaska.gov.
