MARIJUANA CONTROL BOARD MEETING  
AUGUST 10-11, 2015, ANCHORAGE, ALASKA

Pursuant to Alaska Statutes, 17.38.083, the Marijuana Control Board is holding its regular meeting to consider its agenda covering marijuana regulations and other matters that may come before it. The board will take oral testimony only as indicated on the agenda item of unlicensed businesses and only from persons who have received letters from the board related to unlicensed businesses. Persons may attend at any time during the meeting. Comments not related to draft regulations may also be submitted to the board in writing by any person at any time at 550 W. 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 1600, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.

Comments relating to draft regulations will not be taken during this meeting, either orally or in writing. Comments relating to draft regulations must be submitted in writing during the time frames and in the manner set forth in public notices relating to each set of draft regulations.

The meeting will be held in Anchorage on August 10-11, 2015 on the first floor of the Atwood Building located at 550 W. 7<sup>th</sup> Ave, Suite 102, Anchorage, Alaska, 99501.
