

Product Description: Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Capsule oil appear as a golden amber to yellow liquid that is transparent by nature. The liquid takes on the shape of the capsule it is placed in and has a thick, oily consistency when opened. Capsules will come in a variety of strains and flavors with differing THC, CBN, THCa, CBDa, 8 THC, CBGa, THCv, CBDv and CBC levels. Used for inhalation.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Cannabis oil (created using a closed loop extraction or distillation method using plant material (flower, leaves, stems, stalks, roots and seeds), glycerin (optional).
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Heat and combine cannabis oil and glycerin (optional) using a homogenizer until fully blended. Load into capsules (food grade, vegetable capsules or comparable), each with a 5mg serving capacity, totaling ten (10) serving, not to exceed 50mg per bottle. Capsules are stored at room temperature and have an estimated expiration date of one (1) year.

The bag size will be 3" x 4.5" and will contain ten (10), 5mg capsules totaling no more than 50mg per total package. Total THC per product will range 40-99%.



Product Description: Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Tinctures appear as a golden amber to yellow liquid that is transparent by nature. The liquid takes on the shape of the container it is placed in and has a consistency similar to water. Tinctures will come in a variety of strains with differing THC and CBD levels. Used for ingestion.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Cannabis concentrate, alcohol or glycerin and natural flavoring matching either the alcohol or glycerin base (Strawberry Extract, Grape Extract, Green Apple Extract, Cherry Extract or Raspberry Extract).
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Cannabis concentrate and flavoring (Strawberry, Grape, Green Apple, Cherry or Raspberry) will be added to alcohol or glycerin and be combined using a homogenizer until fully blended. Loaded into bottles with a serving pipette topper, totaling ten (10) serving, not to exceed 50mg per bottle. The tincture will be stored at room temperature and have an estimated expiration date of 6 months.

Product Description: Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Chocolate chip cookie bites consist of ten (10), single serving, chocolate chip cookies, each containing 4-6mg of THC, totaling 50mg for the entire package. Each cookie is golden in color, with brown spots, flat, rough in texture and can be either hard or soft. Each cookie is approximately 1" in diameter 1/4" in height.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Marijuana (oil, concentrate or syrup), butter (cream, salt), eggs, vanilla extract, white sugar, brown sugar (molasses & sugar), flour (bleached Wheat Flour, Malted Barley Flour, Niacin, Iron, Thiamin Mononitrate, Riboflavin, Folic Acid), baking soda (sodium bicarbonate), salt(salt, calcium silicate, dextrose, potassium iodide) and chocolate chips.
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Combine butter, white sugar, brown sugar, marijuana, eggs and vanilla extract until homogenized using the homogenization tool. Combine flour, baking soda, salt and combine the two mixtures, then add chocolate chips. Roll into small balls and bake. Expiration is expected to be 1-2 months.



Product Description: Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Einstein Melts consist of ten (10), single serving, milk chocolate balls, each containing 4-6mg of THC, totaling 50mg for the entire package. The chocolate melt has a smooth texture that gets creamy and soft as it warms with a light brown color. Each melt is approximately 3/4" in diameter 1/2" in height.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Natural, unsweetened cocoa powder, butter (cream, salt), marijuana (oil, concentrate or syrup), sugar, powdered sugar, salt (salt, calcium silicate, dextrose, potassium iodide), milk & water.
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Heat water in a saucepan on stove, cream cocoa with marijuana and butter (1:1 ratio), then add to the water. Mix in sugar, salt and milk and ensure chocolate reaches 160 degrees for 5 minutes. Place mixture in molds and place in freezer to harden. Expiration is expected to be at least one (1) year.

Cannna Rocks consist of flavored (Cherry, Strawberry, Watermelon), hard candy that is approximately 3/4" in diameter by 1/2" in height. Each individual serving will contain 4-6mg of THC, totaling 50mg for the entire package. Each candy is green in color. Brittle, transparent.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	White corn syrup, cananbis syrup, water, sugar, natural food coloring (blue= spirulina color, non-gmo maltodextrin, yellow= turmeric color, non-gmo maltodextrin), flavoring (cherry= cherry extract,, alcohol, water, strawberry= strawberry extract, alcohol, water, Watermelon= watermelon extract, alcohol).
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Combine sugar, corn syrup and cannabis syrup and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and once it has reached the correct temperature, remove from heat and add in flavoring and food coloring. Add the mixture into the individual serving size molds and let harden. Expiration is estimated to be one (1) year.


