Your application documents appear to be in order and I have determined that your application is complete for purposes of 3 AAC 306.025(d).

Your application in its entirety will be sent electronically to your local government, your community council if your proposed premises is in Anchorage or certain locations in the Mat-Su Borough, and to any non-profit agencies who have requested notification of applications. The local government will have sixty days to protest the issuance of your license or waive protest.

If you have not yet received all necessary approvals, such as a local license, conditional use permit, site plan review, Fire Marshal approval, or Department of Environmental Conservation approval, we will continue to watch for those pieces to come in. 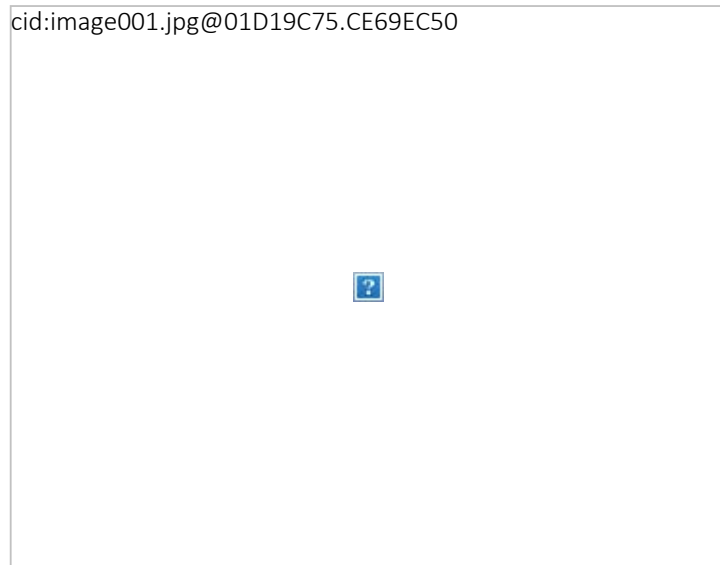
