

COMMERCIAL LEASE

This Lease Agreement (this "Lease") is dated as of March 24, 2016, by and between VGP, Inc. ("Landlord"), and Branden Roybal of Fairbanks, ("Tenant"). The parties agree as follows:

PREMISES. Landlord, in consideration of the lease payments provided in this Lease, leases to Tenant a 2,000 square foot (usable) storage facility in the West Valley Truck Facility (the "Premises") located at 2693 Arla St. Unit # 7& 8, Fairbanks, AK 99709.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION. The legal description for the premises is: LOT 1 BLOCK 8 &TL2040 CARTWRIGHT AIR INDUSTRIAL PARK PLAT 81-193 12/14/81

TERM. The lease term will begin on March 24, 2015 and will terminate on May 1, 2021. Tenant will occupy starting May 1, 2016.

LEASE PAYMENTS. Tenant shall pay to Landlord monthly installments of \$2,550.00, each unit total \$5,100.00 payable in advance on the first day of each month. Lease payments shall be made to the Landlord at P.O. Box 85272, Fairbanks, AK 99708. The payment address may be changed from time to time by the Landlord. Execution of this lease requires payment the day of signing.

SECURITY DEPOSIT. At the time of the signing of this Lease, Tenant shall pay to Landlord, in trust, a security deposit of 1-1/2 times the monthly rent (\$3,825.00) to be held and disbursed for Tenant damages to the Premises (if any) as provided by law. Deposit shall be refundable upon final inspection of leased space & acceptance of area free & clear from normal "wear & tear". Tenant agrees to pay first month's rent and security deposit before entering the premises. Execution of this lease requires payment of security deposit the day of signing.

POSSESSION. Tenant shall be entitled to possession on the first day of the term of this Lease, and shall yield possession to Landlord on the last day of the term of this Lease, unless otherwise agreed by both parties in writing. At the expiration of the term, Tenant shall remove its goods and effects and peaceably yield up the Premises to Landlord in as good a condition as when delivered to Tenant, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

FURNISHINGS. The following furnishings will be provided: 3/4BATHROOM(TOILET, SINK, and SHOWER), 500 GALLON WATER TANK, Air Supply, & HOSE BIB HOOK UPS. Tenant shall return all such items at the end of the lease term in a condition as good as the condition at the beginning of the lease term, except for such deterioration that might result from normal use of the furnishings.

PARKING. Tenant shall be entitled to use 1 parking space(s) for the parking of the

Tenant's customers'/guests' motor vehicle(s).

STORAGE. Tenant shall be entitled to store items of personal property, equipment and materials pertaining to their work.

Items considered Hazardous:

Gasoline (in excess of sealed DOT approved containers), compressed gas (unrestrained), propane tanks (unrestrained),, kerosene, motor oil, acid, grease, corrosives, paint, cleaners, chemicals, narcotics, or hazardous, toxic or biological waste. Asbestos or products containing asbestos are not allowed. You also cannot store fireworks, explosives, weapons or ammunition during the term of this Lease. Landlord shall not be liable for loss of, or damage to, such stored items.

PROPERTY INSURANCE. Landlord and Tenant shall each maintain appropriate insurance for their respective interests in the Premises and property located on the Premises. Tenant shall deliver appropriate evidence to Landlord as proof that adequate insurance is in place prior to occupying the space. Landlord shall receive advance written notice from the insurer prior to any termination of such insurance policies. Tenant shall also maintain any other insurance which Landlord may reasonably require for the protection of Landlord's interest in the Premises. LIABILITY INSURANCE. Tenant shall maintain liability insurance on the Premises in a total aggregate sum of at least \$1,000,000.00. Tenant shall deliver appropriate evidence to Landlord as proof that adequate insurance is in force issued by companies reasonably satisfactory to Landlord. Landlord shall receive advance written notice from the insurer prior to any termination of such insurance policies.

RENEWAL TERMS. It has been agreed upon that the Landlord and Roybal of Fairbanks, have agreed to two unit lease of 5 years. Upon the tenants in units 7 & 8 vacating the facility, the tenant will be able to add additional units to his existing lease as an "amendment". If the Tenant wants to extend this lease then the following terms shall apply:

This Lease shall automatically renew for an additional period of one year per renewal term, unless either party gives written notice of termination no later than 30 days prior to the end of the term or renewal term. The lease terms during any such renewal term shall be the same as those contained in this Lease except that the lease installment payments shall be \$3,000.00 per month.

- Tenant Improvements must meet the approval of the landlord that are necessary for keeping the building health & viability (dust, heat, mold, water, etc.) to protect the facility in its new condition.

Tenant acknowledges that Landlord has fully explained to Tenant the utility rates, charges and services for which Tenant will be required to pay to Landlord (if any), other than those to be paid directly to the third-party provider.

TERMINATION UPON SALE OF PREMISES. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Lease, Landlord may terminate this lease upon 60 days' written notice to Tenant that the Premises and any current lease will be honored by new owner upon sale of facility. If the lease is broken by the facility/building new owner/lien holder, the new owner/lien holder of the facility will execute payment to the tenant in the full amount of lease remaining on contract to the tenant. This provision is written to protect the nature & business of the tenant.

DESTRUCTION OR CONDEMNATION OF PREMISES. If the Premises are partially destroyed by fire or other casualty to an extent that prevents the conducting of Tenant's use of the Premises in a normal manner, and if the damage is reasonably repairable within thirty days after the occurrence of the destruction, and if the cost of repair is less than \$3,000.00, Landlord shall repair the Premises and a just proportion of the lease payments shall abate during the period of the repair according to the extent to which the Premises have been rendered untenantable. 



To protest the application referenced above, please submit your protest within 60 days and show proof of service upon the applicant.

3 AAC 306.010, 3 AAC 306.080, and 3 AAC 306.250 provide that the board will deny an application for a new license if the board finds that the license is prohibited under AS 17.38 as a result of an ordinance or election conducted under AS 17.38 and 3 AAC 306.200.

The local government will have 60 days to protest the issuance of your license or waive protest.

If you have not yet received all necessary approvals, such as a local license, conditional use permit, site plan review, Fire Marshal approval, or Department of Environmental Conservation approval, you should continue to work with those local or state agencies to get the requirements completed.
