If an employee's ID badge is lost or stolen, it should be reported immediately to head office and a replacement obtained. The cost of the replacement badge will be the employee's responsibility unless the replacement is necessitated by a legal name change or a change required by Foxy Enterprises or the MCB.

Upon separation from employment, employees are required to return their employee ID. It is the supervisor's responsibility to ensure the employee's ID badge is returned for destruction before leaving. The ID badge is the property of Foxy Enterprises, administered through the main office and may be revoked at any time due to inappropriate use. The ID badge may be used only by the individual to whom it is issued. Employees may not "loan" their ID badge to anyone for any reason.

Fixed cameras will be on all restricted access areas, security rooms and all points of ingress/egress to limited restricted access areas and exterior or premises. The surveillance system storage device will be secured on site to protect it from employee tampering or theft. Cameras will be motion activated 24-hours a day and the recordings will be keep a minimum of 40 days.

Once the marijuana or marijuana product is ready to be delivered to another licensed marijuana establishment, we (Foxy Enterprises) will weight and package our product in no larger than five (5) pound lots, placed in airtight, food safe, plastic bags and stored in plastic security bins to protect the product from contamination or any toxic or deleterious substance to the marijuana or marijuana product.

Sealed packages or containers cannot be opened during transportation. Tamper proof tape will be attached to any containers.

A transportation manifest provided from the METRC system to include product information, lot numbers, test results and weights will be affixed to the product.

Our property located at 2330 Gunner Lane, (PAN#22711) is currently GU-1 zone. We have been approved for our conditional use permit for commercial marijuana establishment. We, Glen and Barbara Kroshus are the current land owners. We will be living on the property along w/our adult daughter Glenda Kroshus. We intend to take our existing hydroponic greenhouses and grow marijuana under the state and FNSB regulations

Currently there are no primary and secondary school buildings (K-12) including vocational programs, playgrounds, adult and juvenile correctional facilities and housing facilities owned by a public housing authority with children as residents within a 500ft of the property. There are no post-secondary school buildings including but not limited to trade/technical/vocational schools, colleges and universities, within 200ft. There are no youth centers, group homes serving persons ages 18 and under, public swimming pools, state licensed day care facilities, arcades, state licensed substance use treatment provider or facility providing substance abuse use treatment, church buildings within 100ft.

There will be no outdoor storage of marijuana; also no marijuana will be grown outdoors. All structures on the property are existing. The closest greenhouse is 63ft from the property line. The property has a 50ft buffer with tailings and trees.

Our proposed use will be to grow marijuana using a closed hydroponic system. Three greenhouses are 35ft wide by 152ft long by 18ft tall. One greenhouse is 30ft wide by 80ft long by 18ft tall. Each greenhouse has its own well. We plan on just growing marijuana in each greenhouse.

We do not plan on growing year round. This season will be June (state issuing permits) through September depending on the weather. Next year (2016) the season will begin as early as May.

When the hydroponic tomatoes grown in our greenhouses we set each up with individual wells. The hydroponic system doesn't produce any waste water to be disposed of. The leftover stems, roots, and peat moss mixture will be reused for the next season. Any not used will be properly disposed of at the designated borough hazardous material facility. The greenhouses when originally built where set up on the GVEA grid. So no additional lines are required.

Our proposed chain link fence will be 6ft high with barb wire on top. The fence will have three (3) 20ft gates, also added to site plan. We intend to take our existing hydroponic greenhouses and grow marijuana under the state and FNSB regulations

Currently there are no primary and secondary school buildings (K-12) including vocational programs, playgrounds, adult and juvenile correctional facilities and housing facilities owned by a public housing authority with children as residents within a 500ft of the property. There are no post-secondary school buildings including but not limited to trade/technical/vocational schools, colleges and universities, within 200ft. There are no youth centers, group homes serving persons ages 18 and under, public swimming pools, state licensed day care facilities, arcades, state licensed substance use treatment provider or facility providing substance abuse use treatment, church buildings within 100ft.

There will be no outdoor storage of marijuana; also no marijuana will be grown outdoors. All structures on the property are existing. The closest greenhouse is 63ft from the property line. The property has a 50ft buffer with tailings and trees.

Our proposed use will be to grow marijuana using a closed hydroponic system. Three greenhouses are 35ft wide by 152ft long by 18ft tall. One greenhouse is 30ft wide by 80ft long by 18ft tall. Each greenhouse has its own well. We plan on just growing marijuana in each greenhouse.

We do not plan on growing year round. This season will be June (state issuing permits) through September depending on the weather. Next year (2016) the season will begin as early as May.

When we had the hydroponic tomatoes grown in our greenhouses we set each up with individual wells. The hydroponic system doesn't produce any waste water to be disposed of. The leftover stems, roots, and peat moss mixture will be reused for the next season. Any not used will be properly disposed of at the designated borough hazardous material facility. The greenhouses when originally built where set up on the GVEA grid. So no additional lines are required.

Our proposed chain link fence will be 6ft high with barb wire on top. The fence will have three (3) 20ft gates, also added to site plan. The fence on the north side will be 107ft from edge of property. The south side will be 50ft from edge of the property. The west end will be 546ft from edge of property. The east end will be 200ft from the edge of the property. At this time we plan on being a seasonal marijuana cultivation facility, (May through September depending on the weather). There will be three (3) full time employees for the duration of the season. An additional eight (8) employees will be needed during the harvest. The anticipated harvest will occur every 45-60 days.

Employees will be required to obtain a marijuana handler permit card prior to being employed by Foxy Enterprises. Foxy Enterprises will keep a copy of the valid permit on file.

Employees will be on site from 7am to 9pm, seven (7) days a week during the season. The 2016 season will be June through September depending on the weather.

June

3 Full time employees, one will be our greenhouse manger, to stock the greenhouses with plants.

July (harvest time)

3 Full time employees to fill tanks, mix nutrients and check on the plants.

8 additional full time employees to trim the plants.

August

3 Full time employees to fill tanks, mix nutrients and check on the plants.

September (harvest time)

3 Full time employees to fill tanks, mix nutrients and check on the plants.

September (end)

3 Full time employees to empty tanks, drain irrigation systems, and winterize the greenhouses for next season. Also attend to any other duties as needed.

Any odor concerns will be handled with carbon filters covering the exhaust fans in each of the greenhouse.

The property is large enough for parking and maneuvering of our three (3) full time employees. It will still have adequate room during harvest with the additional eight (8) full time employees. The parking areas are tailings compacted and covered with a fine layer of sand. These areas have been driven on for over 10 years plus with no problems.

Currently our property is protected by Steese Volunteer Fire Department for EMS/Fire service. The Alaska State Troopers will provide law enforcement.

Per 3 AAC 306.455, we the marijuana cultivation facility will provide a sample of each harvest batch of marijuana to a state licensed testing facility. This sample will be collected randomly, homogenous sample for testing by segregating harvested marijuana into batches of individual strains of bud and flower, then a random sample will be selected from each batch in the amount required by the state licensed testing facility. Our greenhouse manager will be responsible for assisting the testing facility representative. The manager will then prepare a signed statement showing each sample has been randomly selected for testing. A copy will be keep for our records, and one will be sent to the testing facility. A sample of up to seven grams will be taken from a five (5) pound lot of useable marijuana. This sample will then be packaged in tampering resistant packaging, to be transported to the testing facility in compliance with 3 AAC 306.750.

Our greenhouse manager will then segregate the entire batch from which the testing sample was selected, until the state licensed testing facility reports the results. This segregated batch will be stored in a secure, cool, and dry location, to prevent it from becoming contaminated or losing its efficacy. We the cultivation facility will not sell or transport any marijuana from the segregated batch until the state licensed testing facility has completed its testing and provided written results to us. All of this will be logged in the marijuana inventory tracking system. These results will be maintained as part of business records.

Per 3 AAC 306.465, we the marijuana cultivation facility will bear all costs of testing under this subsection. The board or director orders random sampling under this section, the director will identify a licensed marijuana testing facility. 

If a protest is filed, the board will deny the application unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable. To protest the application referenced above, please submit your protest within 60 days and show proof of service upon the applicant.

3 AAC 306.010, 3 AAC 306.080, and 3 AAC 306.250 provide that the board will deny an application for a new license if the board finds that the license is prohibited under AS 17.38 as a result of an ordinance or election conducted under AS 17.38 and 3 AAC 306.200.

3 AAC 306.010(c) provides that the board will not issue a license when a local government protests an application on the grounds that the applicant's proposed licensed premises are located in a place within the local government where a local zoning ordinance prohibits the marijuana establishment, unless the local government has approved a variance from the local ordinance.



I have received your application for a Standard Marijuana Cultivation Facility license. Our staff has reviewed your application after receiving your application and required fees. Your application documents appear to be in order, and I have determined that your application is complete for purposes of 3 AAC 306.025(d).

Your application is now considered complete and will be sent electronically, in its entirety, to your local government, your community council if your proposed premises is in Anchorage or certain locations in the Mat-Su Borough, and to any non-profit agencies who have requested notification of applications. The local government will have 60 days to protest the issuance of your license or waive protest.

If you have not yet received all necessary approvals, such as a local license, conditional use permit, site plan review, Fire Marshal approval, or Department of Environmental Conservation approval, you should continue to work with those local or state agencies to get the requirements completed. At this time, at the direction of the Marijuana Control Board, I am determining your application to be complete without sending your fingerprint card(s) to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for independent verification of your lack of a disqualifying criminal history. The fingerprint card(s) will be forwarded on an as yet undetermined date when DPS and the FBI are ready to receive and process it. Your application status in the application database will be changed to "Complete" today.

Your application may be considered by the board while some approvals are still pending. However, your license will not be finally issued and ready to operate until all necessary approvals are received and a preliminary inspection of your premises by AMCO enforcement staff is completed.

Your application will be scheduled for the July 7, 2016 board meeting for Marijuana Control Board consideration. Because July 7, 2016 is less than 60 days from today, the board will not grant or deny your application before July 31, 2016 unless your local government waives its right to protest per 3 AAC 306.075(a)(1).
