

We have received your objection. However, because your objection does not reference any specific application as required under 3 AAC 306.065 this objection/comment would be treated as a general objection/comment and forwarded to the general email of the Marijuana Control Board which is marijuana@alaska.gov . It would not be filed as part of any marijuana application(s)

Now, you are a registered (for lack of a better term) community council with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough which means that when an application is determined complete by the director of this office, the community council **which name is provided by the applicant**, gets notified of the complete application. At that time is when the community council has the opportunity to request a copy of the entire complete application and lodge an objection which should include all the pertaining information of the specific application to include notifying the applicant of the objection. Furthermore, we

strongly suggest that you also contact the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to voice your concerns.

As for the board meeting today, I am not sure if there are any applications that are within your community council but it is too late for any objection/comment to be added to the agenda.
