Good, LLC, is requesting board approval of a new marijuana product in accordance with 3 AAC 306.525(c).

This product manufacturing license was approved with delegation by the board on December 7, 2016, with three products submitted: N-Butane Concentrate, Ice Water Concentrate, and Vape Pen with Oil. The licensee was put into active status on April 11, 2017, but the license is not yet effective.

The new product, "Rosin," is a concentrate that will be created by applying heat and pressure to "flowers or hash and kief." The resulting rosin will be packaged in jars.

The submitted MJ-16 form indicates that the equipment used to create the rosin is a prepress mold with filter bags. This equipment is not listed in the MJ-5 application approved by the board on December 7, 2016. 3 AAC 306.520(3)(A) requires that the operating plan include a description of the equipment to be used to create concentrates. This is in contrast to 3 AAC 306.525(b)(2) which requires the production procedure and detailed manufacturing process for each product. Thus, in accordance with 3 AAC 306.520(3)(A), Good, LLC, should submit an operating plan amendment to request board approval of the equipment at the July 2017 meeting. The board has authorized the director to give temporary approval of operating plan changes pending board approval at that meeting.

Recommendation: Approval with delegation, with the following condition: submit an operating plan amendment to request board approval of equipment for creating rosin, in accordance with 3 AAC 306.520(3)(A).

The board should consider requiring more contrast between the writing and the background for the Warning Label ("Middle Label" on last page of MJ-16). While it appears that the purple writing/brown background was approved for previous labels for this licensee, the lack of contrast between the dark colors makes the warning labels difficult to read.

This proposed new marijuana product form is required for a marijuana product manufacturing facility licensee who is seeking Marijuana Control Board approval of a new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate for production at its licensed premises, under 3 AAC 306.100 and 3 AAC 306.525. **The required \$250 proposed new marijuana product fee may be made by check, cashier's check, or money order.**

This form must be completed and submitted to AMCO's main office prior to production of any new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate. **The proposed new marijuana product may not be produced unless and until the Marijuana Control Board has approved of the product.**

Please note that licensees seeking approval of more than one proposed new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate must submit a separate completed copy of this form and pay a separate fee for each proposed new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate.

Product Description: Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Rosin refers to a solventless extraction process that utilizes a combination of heat and pressure to nearly instantaneously squeeze resinous sap from your initial starting material. With cannabis, this method is incredibly versatile in that it can either be used with flowers or hash and kief to create a full-melt hash oil. The result is a translucent, sappy, and sometimes shatter-like product.
Ingredients: This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	1) Load hash or flower into filter bag, 2) Load filter bag into prepress mold, 3) Load first filter bag into second filter bag, 4) Line press with food grade parchment paper and preheat press plates to 220 degrees F 5) Place loaded filter bag, 6) Press plates together to create pressure of 10psi, gradually increasing to 100psi, 7) Collect oil on parchment paper
