Looks and feels like regular coconut oil - white to off-white solid (hard) oil when below 76 degrees Fahrenheit, clear oil liquid when heated above 76 degrees Fahrenheit. Assumes the shape of the container, oily texture.
<b>Ingredients:</b> This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Organic Virgin Coconut Oil (250mL) Cannabis Butane Hash Oil (BHO) Extract (Will test for potency and adjust accordingly)
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Place 250 mL of raw unrefined Coconut oil in a double boiler and set temperature to 220 degrees F. Make sure to keep temperature below 220 degrees F. Mix in Butane Hash Oil cannabis extract, and stir into mixture. Let mixture heat for 1 hour. Check on mixture to note formation of CO2 bubbles that denotes decarboxylation. Stir mixture, and keep heat on until there are no more CO2 bubbles forming. Pour oil into cooling pan and place in the fridge to cool down.

<b>Ingredients:</b> This box is not applicable to marijuana concentrates	Fruit Juice 5471 grams, Organic Cane Sugar 3697 grams, Tapioca Syrup 1376 grams, Tartaric Acid 97 grams, Pectin 159 grams, Butane Hash Oil Cannabis Extract approximately 25 grams (depends on the THC strength), granulated sugar 1200 grams, and citric acid 120 grams
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Step 1 Combine fruit Juice and Concentrates and place over low heat. Step 2 Combine 20% of the cane sugar with the apple pectin set aside. Step 3 Measure Tapioca syrup, the rest of the cane sugar and tartaric acid all in separate bowls - set aside. Step 4 Bring Juice 160 degrees (Boiling). Step 5 Slowly add in Cane sugar + Pectin mixture stirring continuously. Step 6 Bring juice/pectin mix back up to a boil. Step 7 Slowly add in Tapioca syrup. Step 8 Bring back up to a boil. Step 9 Slowly add in the rest of the cane sugar. Step 10 Bring the mixture up to 215 degrees, while stirring continuously. Step 11 Add in Butane Hash OilCannabis extract, mix for 1 minute. Step 12 Adding Tartaric Acid, mix for 1 more minute. Step 13 Pour mixture out onto Quartz slab, let it cool overnight. Step 14 Cut into 1" by 1/2" pieces. Step 15 Let Product "cure" at room temperature for 5 days. Step 16 Coat in sugar/citric acid mixture. Step 17 Package.
