The licensee contacted me on February 20, 2018, stating that testing of batches of two products, Sunny Day Granola and Orange Milk Chocolate Chip Cookies, showed that the batches were homogenous and free of microbials but approximately double the potency per serving. The licensee requested permission to adjust the serving size and retest to ensure the new servings are compliant.

I authorized retests of the new serving sizes (half of the previously approved serving sizes) but required that an MJ-15 operating plan change be filed to add the new serving sizes as options for these two products.

Dear Ms. McConnell,

We are requesting your guidance concerning the serving size of our products based upon test results from Steep Hill. Two of our products, Sunny Day Granola and Orange Milk Chocolate Chip Cookies, have tested higher than anticipated as this is the first commercial batch produced by Lady Gray and we are hoping to alter the serving size to ensure the potency amounts are well below the required limits.

Steep Hill has confirmed that both these products, Sunny Day Granola and Orange Milk Chocolate Chip Cookies, are homogenous and have passed microbial but that the potency failed making the number of mgs of THC over the legal limit, therefore the serving sizes are too big. Because potency is determined after a batch has been tested (and therefore after a batch has actually been produced), Lady Gray can salvage both batches by simply adjusting the serving size on the package and retest the revised serving size to ensure the THC MGs are within the legal limits. With your approval and allowance, if we were to be able to reduce the serving size, we would be in compliance and salvage thousands of dollars in product. Please see the attached results from Steep Hill.

With actually halving the serving size of each of these products, we are still in full compliance and spirit of the regulations adhering to the serving size of 4mg-6mg each. Please see the attachments with the labels and the before and after pictures of what the products will look like by halving the serving size (for example the cookie before was one serving per cookie and now it would be cut down the middle and each cookie half would be made into 5mg servings). We have consulted with Steep Hill and they are aware and ready to retest these products upon approval of the serving size update from you.

Lady Gray is committed to transparency and abiding by State regulations in all that we do. It is our desire to be partners with the State of Alaska in this process ensuring quality products and consumer protection.

Thank you, we look forward to your guidance and thank you in advance for your attention and prompt as possible response to ensure the freshness of our product. We know you are extremely busy and appreciate your commitment to the health and safety of the public and furtherance of our new commercial MJ industry.

Ms. Grossl,

My apologies for not responding when I said I would.

On the Orange Chocolate Chip Cookies, your two labels (previously approved and proposed updated) contain the same net weight. Your application states that you propose a 4 cookie package and a 10 cookie package. I can't tell which one your packaging is for. Obviously the 10 cookie package would be a problem.

By this email, I authorize you to retest the Orange Chocolate Chip Cookies with ½ cookie servings, but you may not package any for sale until we are more clear on the packaging issue next week. Also, to make this compliant with the regulations, I will need you to submit an MJ-15 (which I can temporarily approve) to add the new serving size as an option. We can discuss that next week.

For the Sunny Day Granola, I have a concern that neither staff nor the board caught during your application review. The granola packaging does not comply with 3 AAC 306.565(b)(2), which states that the packaging must "if the marijuana product contains multiple servings, be designed so that the marijuana product itself has markings or demarcations clearly delineating each serving of the product;" Your proposed packaging appears to have all the servings together with no markings or demarcations (which really can't be done with granola). I understand you provide the serving size on the packaging, but it is still non-compliant. This will need to be brought back to the board for review—and please note that I will be reviewing all approved products for all manufacturing licensees for this issue and bringing any non-compliant ones back to the board. I'm not picking on you.

I authorize a retest of the Sunny Day Granola with 1 Tablespoon servings, but you may not package any for sale. We will discuss further next week, but you will need to package the granola into single serving packages, and this will need to be part of the MJ-15.

The packaging description of Sunny Day Granola is being revised so that each serving is individually packaged into a zippered pouch within the larger exit package instead of the multiple servings packaged into one mylar bag to be measured by the consumer.

The labeling will be printed on waterproof labels to retain integrity in the freezer. It meets ASTM D3475 (American Society for Testing and Material Child Resistant) standards. Two serving size package options will be available: 1/2 cookie servings and 1 whole cookie servings. Each serving will not exceed 5mg THC whether the serving is half of a cookie or a whole cookie.




