Vape Pen Oil appear as a golden amber to yellow liquid that is transparent by nature. The liquid takes on the shape of the container it is placed in and has a consistency similar to oil. Vape Pen Oil will come in a variety of strains and flavors with varying THC and CBD levels. Used for inhalation. Product will be placed in vape pens and vape pen cartridges.

Ingredients:

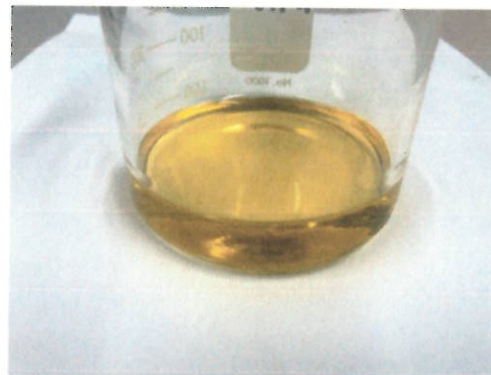
Cannabis oil, glycerin, propylene glycol, or MCT (Medium-chain triglycerides)(carrier oils are optional) and a variety of natural and strain specific flavors.

Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:

Cannabis oil, carrier oil (optional) and flavoring will be heated and combined using a homogenizer until fully blended and then loaded into bottles and vape pen cartridges (.5g to 2g total per product) following the SOP. The vape pen oil will be stored at room temperature and have an estimated expiration date of one (1) year.

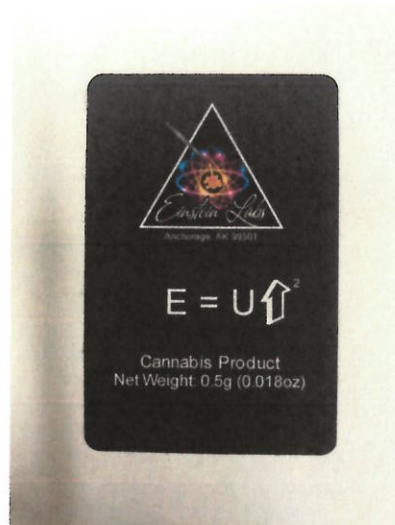

Standard vape pens and hand held vape pens will be packaged in black mylar bags (approx. 4" by 7") with a clear back. Refill cartridges will be packaged in black mylar bags (approx. 3.5" by 5.5") with a clear back.

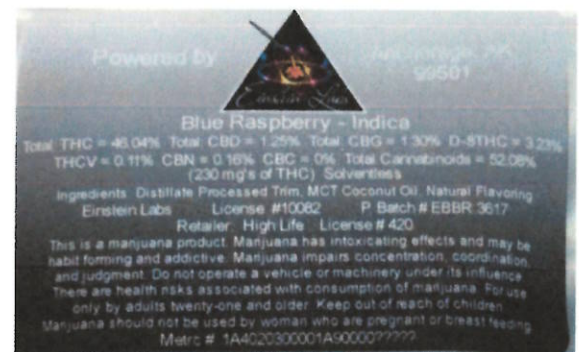

Each chocolate comes in a single serving circle disc approx. 1.5" across by 1/4" thick with a total weight of approx. 8.5 grams (ten, 5mg servings, totaling 50mg per package). Each disc has a medallion emblem with the word "THC" on it and is hard to the touch but melts as it gets warm. Orange Dreamsicle is light orange, Cookies and Cream is off white with dark cookie flecks, and the Milk Chocolate Toffee is light brown in color.

Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Honu chocolate edibles are created by combining ingredients until fully combined using heat and other proprietary methods and then blended with cannabis extract until fully homogenized using a proprietary dosing method. Chocolate is then placed in molds to form the end product with the medallion "THC" label on top. Ten (10), 5mg single servings are then placed in a bag, totaling 50mg per package.

Packaging will consist of each piece of chocolate being individually wrapped in clear plastic or foil (Toffee= Purple, Orange= bronze, and Cookies & C.= silver) then placed in a mylar bag approximately 4" x 6". Each bag will hold ten (10) pieces of chocolate, each piece having 5mg of THC, with a total of 50mg's of THC per package. Packaging will consist of a child resistant white bag with the name of the product, flavor, serving sizes, symbol & words that show that the package contains marijuana and picture of the chocolate on the front with ingredients, warnings and all other required state specifics being listed on the back of the package.

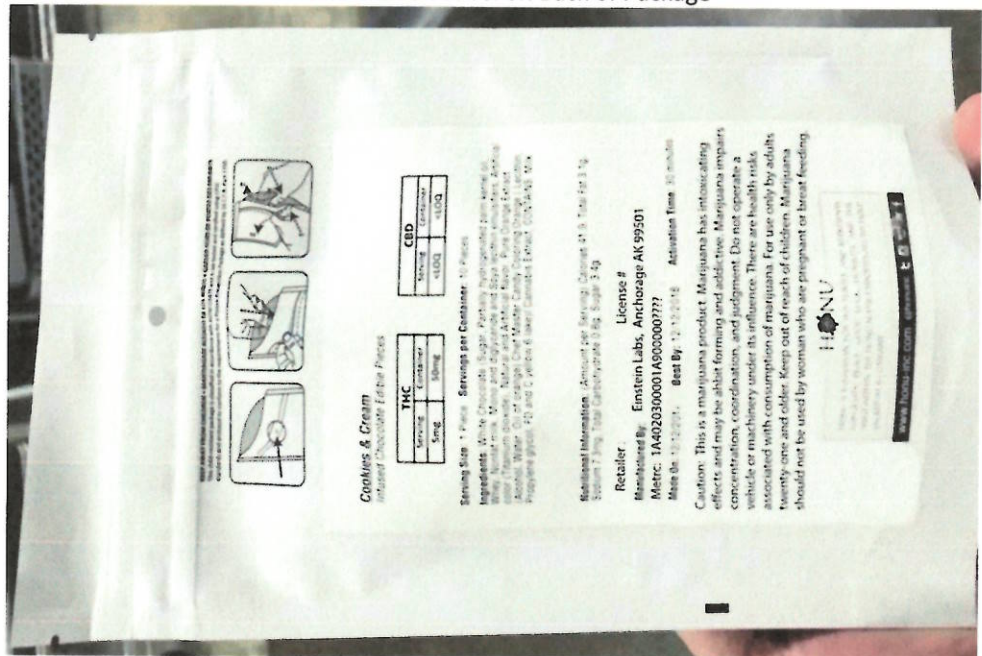
