Dear Ms. McConnell,

Thank you for making an effort and ask the board to clarify their denial and thank you for the recordings of the board's reasoning.

First I would like to initiate informal conference with you or you and the board.

I see how the board may see the problem with my premises and I want to ask you and the board to take another look at this issue. One more time I want to try to prove it to you that there is no security or safety or diversion issue in my business set up.

I worked very hard trying to make it nice, safe and clean place for these plants to grow. I really don't see why you can't approve entire house as restricted area. Me and the other occupant have no problem with cameras covering entire house and recording all areas of the house and especially areas under cultivation and we have no problem waring badges all the time, we were doing that for the past four month and we get use to the fact that we are on cameras all the time it doesn't bother us at all.

I am attaching two sets of diagrams for you to review:

First diagram is for the entire house as restricted access area and cultivation is limited to two rooms only that will be locked at all times.

Additional diagram is in addition to the first diagram and it is just for you to see the locations of the cameras and the areas that I propose not to cover. I don't see how I can harm the process by not being on camera when I sleep. There is no cameras in the bedroom but you can clearly see the exits from the cultivation rooms and if anything would be moved from or to those rooms it can clearly be seen on multiple cameras. I understand that the regulations are clearly stating that all restricted areas need to be covered by cameras but even if the bedroom will not be on camera Amco inspector will always be welcome to check the bedroom or bathrooms at any time. I will still keep the grow areas to those two rooms and will not be moving plants from those rooms. And both grow rooms are completely covered with cameras in all directions.

Second diagram is for having entire house as licensed premises and having only one room upstairs as a restricted access area for growing. If this will be acceptable by the board I would like you to consider it as my final diagram.


Because the board bring this up on the recording I have to say that I have very good ventilation system in place that there is no smell in the house, not only used air is filtered through carbon filter and pushed outside by the fan but another fan is constantly bringing fresh air inside, not only there is no smell in the grow room but hardly any in the tent where the plants are sealed. Rooms are locked all the time and the grow tents are sealed and the air in it is fresh and controlled by heaters and humidifiers and dehumidifiers to keep the right temperature and humidity.

I would appreciate very much if you can reconsider your denial.




