On 05/07/2018, AMCO Enforcement received information from METRC reporting entries of marijuana plants in your METRC inventory showing a plant life cycle of less than 14 days. In a review of the your METRC inventory I found 30 plants of the Rollex OG strain that were all listed as planted on 01/04/2018, they were all reported in vegetative stage on 02/21/2018 and then all 30 plants were placed in flowering stage on 02/22/2018. This indicates the 30 plants all shared a one day vegetative stage.

I spoke with Brittany GITSCHEL. She informed me the plants were entered into vegetative stage late because of a communication error between their growers and office personnel. GITSCHEL said the batch should have moved into vegetative state 01/18/2018 rather than 02/21/2018. GITSCHEL said the plants were tagged at the appropriate time. GITSCHEL said the reported flowering stage date of 02/22/2018 was correct.

On May 29, 2018 it was found 141 harvest batches had been "finished" in the METRC system with the waste weight being over-reported, causing 100 of the harvest batches to appear they had not generated any packages when in fact they had. The remaining 41 of the harvest batches had never had any packages created from them, to include a package for testing. The destruction of the entire 41 harvest batches was not reported to AMCO with the three day's notification as required by regulation (Waste reporting issue previously addressed in NOV Case AB 18-000529 issued on 5-10-18). The "finishing" of the harvest batches occurred primarily on 5-1-18 and 5-15-18 when the licensee, Brittany Gitschel was attempting to clean up and rectify her METRC account.

Aurora Blaze submitted waste reports with excess waste for the month of February via email on 3/28/18. On 3/29/18 I went to the establishment and spoke with the manager as the licensees were not available. It was determined by the employee's own admittance the waste was not being held for 3 days prior to reporting as required. Video footage was requested for 40 days for waste disposal.

On 4/4/18 I met with licensee Brittany Gitschel at the AMCO office whom confirmed the waste was not being reported with 3 days notice to the board and AMCO before it was destroyed. She stated the video footage was damaged due to a water flood and she was unaware it was not recording for 40 days. Only 23 days of coverage was available and provided. The waste destruction area camera view was partially covered by a tool box.

This is a violation of 3 AAC 306.740(c)(1) Waste Disposal and 3 AAC 306.720(c)(e).

Aurora Blaze, LLC received a Notice of Violation (AMCO Case #AB 18-000529) for improper reporting of marijuana plant waste and an inability to provide forty (40) days of video footage in the month of February. August 6, 2018

Aurora Blaze, LLC (License #12328) received a Notice of Violation (AMCO Case #AB 18-0517) on May 31, 2018 for reporting late a move of 30 plants of Rollex OG into the vegetative stage of Metrc. This happened due to a communication error between Aurora Blaze's office personnel and our growers. The plants should have moved into the vegetative stage in Metrc on January 18, 2018 instead of February 21, 2018 and we apologize for the mistake. We have since taken steps to better our communication between the two departments so that this error does not happen again.



August 6, 2018

Aurora Blaze, LLC (License #12328) received a Notice of Violation (AMCO Case #AB 18-000739) on June 1, 2018 for "finishing" 141 harvest batches in Metrc and over reporting waste weights. This was due to a misunderstanding that Investigator Stonecipher has since cleared up for us. In the harvest tab of Metrc the "Moisture Loss" category is actually called "Weight". This confused our staff, because the weight numbers in that section didn't match the actual weights we were getting off every strain per harvest. In an effort to fix what we thought was wrong we wasted out the numbers in the "weight" category. Investigator Stonecipher also let us know that harvests shouldn't be "finished" until every package from a harvest has been sold, so we won't finish anymore harvests until all product is sold from now on. Regarding the 41 harvest batches that were never tested (due to the small size of each batch amount), those harvests took place before we were properly keeping track of our waste weights and reporting them to AMCO. In the month of May, Aurora Blaze received an NOV for our improper reporting of marijuana plant waste and corrective actions were immediately performed. All waste is now labeled and stored in one area of the building for a minimum of three (3) days under direct camera surveillance. Waste logs are sent to AMCO on a weekly basis to remain in compliance.
