FROM: Erika McConnell, Director RE: Request to Revoke Handler Permit of
Quincy James Iyatunguk, #17827

On October 29, 2019, Mr. Quincy Iyatunguk was arrested at Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport. He confessed to concealing 8.8 grams of heroin in his rectum. Mr. Iyatunguk was charged with a class A felony offense of manufacturing or delivering any amount of a schedule IA controlled substance, and possessing any amount of a schedule IA controlled substance with intent to manufacture or deliver.

Mr. Iyatunguk is the manager of Gudlief Organization retail marijuana store in Nome, license #11119. He was intending to travel to Nome and was transporting marijuana from Alaska Weeds, license #14083, located at 6209 Mike Street in Anchorage, to Gudlief Organization at 303-C West E Street in Nome. Mr. Iyatunguk's shipment had a Metrc manifest, although it did not state the correct transporter. An NOV has been issued to Alaska Weeds.

AMCO retrieved the marijuana from the airport law enforcement and returned it to Alaska Weeds.

I request the board revoke handler permit #17827 issued to Quincy James Iyatunguk.
