Product Manufacturing Facility

Enlighten Extractions, LLC, a limited liability company in good standing owned by Jane Stinson 50%, Leah Levinton 25%, and Evan Levinton 25%, applied for a marijuana product manufacturing facility. Most application documents were submitted in October of 2019.

The applicant submitted documents for 52 products. During review, the licensing examiner provided comments to the applicant, attempting to match the requirements of the board in its most recent actions. Portions of the incomplete letter (bolded) provided to the applicant and highlighted in the applicant's appeal, stated the following:

- **All Edible Products:**
 - **If the base marijuana ingredient in a product is different (canna oil, distillate, canna butter, etc.), the different varieties should be submitted as separate products. The products should also differentiate between different varieties in some way (in addition to the ingredients label), such as variations on the name or packaging options.**
- **All In-House Ingredients/Wholesale products for other manufacturers (except HTFSE):**
 - **If the base marijuana ingredient is different, each variety should be submitted as a different product.**

These are consistent with the board's direction to Happy Valley #20438 on September 12, 2019, when the board required separate products for different marijuana ingredients.

- **Canna-liquid:**
 - **Include a list of all proposed emulsifiers in the Ingredients section.**

In the application, "example" emulsifiers are provided: lecithin and vegetable oil. With only three ingredients (water, an emulsifier, cannabis concentrate), the emulsifier appears to be one of the main ingredients. The board has required other licensees, such as Stoney Moose Kitchens #16991, to apply for separate ingredients when a main ingredient changes.

- **Distillate Cartridge and Distillate Darts:**
 - **The Standard Production Procedure states that flavoring or HTFSE [High Terpene Full Spectrum Extract] may be added as needed. Be specific regarding whether or**

not it will be included. If so, include a list of all proposed flavors. Note that if additional ingredients are added, these products should be re-categorized as Marijuana Products and not Concentrates.

The board has allowed a single product to contain multiple flavor options, but a product with flavoring and a product without flavoring appear to be two separate products. In addition, the flavors have generally been listed, although this may not always have been the case.

At 3 AAC 306.990(b)(11), “concentrate” or “marijuana concentrate” " means resin, oil, wax, or any other substance produced by extracting or isolating cannabinoids, THC, or other components from a marijuana plant or from materials harvested from a marijuana plant.

At AS 17.38.900(15), “marijuana products” means concentrated marijuana products and marijuana products that are comprised of marijuana and other ingredients and are intended for use or consumption, such as, but not limited to, edible products, ointments, and tinctures.

It may be a minor point, but the statutes and regulations indicate that concentrate contains only marijuana, and products contain marijuana and other ingredients.

The issues set forth in this memo help illustrate the struggles of AMCO staff (including management) relating to how the board would like to regulate products. A discussion was started at the last meeting. Staff has requested me to ask you the following questions:

1. I need clarification from the Board regarding how you would like marijuana products with differing sources of THC to be submitted, as decisions have not always been consistent. If the THC ingredient is different, would you like the variants to be submitted as separate products? If they are submitted as separate products, do they need to be labeled differently, or is the list of ingredients on the packaging adequate? If the THC ingredients are similar, can they be interchanged? An example from this application is “Brownie Bites”:

A proposed ingredient in this product is “cannabis concentrate (shall either be canna butter, canna coconut oil, canna-liquid, shatter, distillate, crumble, budder, kief, tincture, or sauce)”. The Standard Product Procedure states “Mix cannabis concentrate with ingredients to create infused brownie batter”. The product is then mixed until homogenous, portioned out, and cooked (also packaged, stored, tested, etc.).

Canna Butter and Canna Coconut Oil (both proposed products) seem to be similar ingredients, since the marijuana is decarboxylated during the production process. I believe that Budder, Crumble, Distillate, Kief, Sauce, and Shatter would require additional decarboxylation (unless the time that they are baked is adequate to achieve this), but this is not a step included in the production process.

How many varieties of ingredients and production processes can be included for a single product before they need to be considered as separate products?

2. Many products that have been approved include multiple solvents in the Standard Production Procedure (SPP). For example, many of the proposed concentrates with this application use the same language in the SPP, other than the name. The solvents proposed are hydrocarbons, CO2, and/or ethanol. How specific do applicants need to be regarding which solvents they will use? Is it acceptable to just list them all, regardless of how the products will actually be made?
3. Many products also list multiple emulsifiers, such as MCT oil (medium chain triglycerides), propylene glycol, TEC Temper, polyethylene glycol, and other variants. How specific do the applications need to be, particularly given lack of knowledge of the possible health risks associated with some emulsifiers, and when do different emulsifiers mean different products?
4. If a change to a product is requested, and the approved product is not consistent with the board's requirements, what should staff do? How should we proceed with transfers and MJ-15s for products that have already been approved with certain language that may no longer fit with the board's current interpretation?

Clarification and guidance (some of which will come through the "umbrella products" regulations project) will not only assist your staff, but will help the licensees and applicants understand how to be successful.

The AMCO Office has reviewed the documents submitted for the proposed marijuana establishment license referenced above. This letter is notice under 3 AAC 306.025(e)(2) that your application is incomplete and additional items are needed to complete the application. The additional items that need correction or resubmittal are listed below—please be sure to read the entire letter. **Please note that if the corrections and/or additional documents submitted in response to this letter are not found to be complete, your application will be returned to you in accordance with 3 AAC 306.025(e)(1), and you will need to file a new application and pay a new fee should you wish to continue pursuing licensure.**

- **Online Application**
 - The zip code listed on this application, 99507, is inconsistent with the lease documents provided that identify the zip code as 99503. I have rolled your application back to New status so that you can correct the zip code in MyAlaska. Once you re-submit the application, a new Advertisement Notice and Public Notice will be generated. Be sure to save copies of these Notices for your records and corrections.
- **MJ-00 Application Certifications**
 - Page 1, Section 1 – Establishment Information for everyone:
 - Please correct the zip code.
- **MJ-01 Operating Plan**
 - Page 1, Section 1 – Establishment & Contact Information:
 - Please correct the zip code of the premises address.
 - Page 2, Section 3.1:
 - Your response describes processes for admitting visitors in the facility, but does not address how unescorted members of the public will be prevented from accessing restricted access areas on this proposed premises.
 - Page 10, Section 9.2:
 - Your response includes the phrase “Including, but not limited to”. Please remove this phrase and be specific regarding the proposed advertising.
- **MJ-02 Premises Diagram**
 - Page 1, Section 1 – Establishment Information:
 - Please correct the zip code.

- Diagram 1 + 2:
 - Include the room dimensions on your diagram.
- Diagram 3:
 - In color, outline or shade (and label) which building your proposed premises is within.
- Diagram 4 + 5:
 - The diagram provided does not include the information required on Diagram 5. Please remove the Diagram 5 label and submit a separate Diagram 5.
- **MJ-05 Manufacturing Supplemental**
 - Page 1, Section 1 – Establishment Information:
 - Please correct the zip code.
- **MJ-05 – Marijuana Products**
 - All Concentrates (excluding Pull N’ Snap, Shatter, and Terp Darts):
 - In the Packaging Description of many of the proposed concentrates, you state that the product will be stored in “a small container”. Please specify the materials that will be used for these containers.
 - CO2 Cartridge:
 - In the Standard Production Procedure, specify whether or not winterization will be part of the production process.
 - Crystalline and Diamonds:
 - Except for the image used in the Depiction section, these products appear to be identical. How are they different?
 - Dry Sift and Kief:
 - These products appear to be identical. How are they different?
 - Live Rosin:
 - The Standard Production Procedure is the same procedure used in making Kief. Are there any additional steps in the manufacturing process?
 - All Edible Products:
 - The Product Descriptions of some products state that they will come in various geometric shapes. Specify the proposed shapes for each product.
 - If a product will be offered in multiple flavors, include a list of all proposed flavors (and colors) in the Product Description and/or Ingredients section.
 - If the base marijuana ingredient in a product is different (canna oil, distillate, canna butter, etc.), the different varieties should be submitted as separate products. The products should also differentiate between different varieties in some way (in addition to the ingredients label), such as variations on the name or packaging options.
 - In the Packaging Description, be specific regarding the packaging options and THC per serving varieties being proposed. For example, a product might contain two-and-a-half milligrams of THC per serving and be packaged in batches of ten or twenty pieces totaling twenty-five or fifty milligrams of THC per package, respectively.
 - Enlighten Caps:
 - In the Product Description or Ingredients section, define what MCT oil is. It can be shortened to “MCT oil” in other sections.
 - The Product Description, Ingredients, and Standard Production procedure are inconsistent regarding the inclusion of MCT oil, olive oil, or vegetable glycerin. Each section includes different ingredients. Please include all proposed ingredients in the Ingredients section and revise your responses so they are consistent.
 - Enlighten Mist:
 - This product includes MCT oil as an ingredient. When is it added during the production procedure?

- Bliss, Cold Brew, Delight, and Nectar:
 - In the Packaging Description, specify what size bottles will be used in addition to the total number of servings and THC per serving.
 - The sample images provided do not show the serving size demarcations that are mentioned in the description.
- All In-House Ingredients/Wholesale products for other manufacturers (except HTFSE):
 - If the base marijuana ingredient is different, each variety should be submitted as a different product.
- Canna-liquid:
 - Include a list of all proposed emulsifiers in the Ingredients section.
- Caviar Joints:
 - The sample image in the Depiction is very blurry. Please provide a better image.
- Caviar Buds – no revisions necessary.
- Distillate Cartridge and Distillate Darts:
 - The Standard Production Procedure states that flavoring or HTFSE may be added as needed. Be specific regarding whether or not it will be included. If so, include a list of all proposed flavors. Note that if additional ingredients are added, these products should be re-categorized as Marijuana Products and not Concentrates.
- **MJ-07 Public Notice Posting Affidavit**
 - Section 1 – Establishment Information:
 - The zip code listed in this section is inconsistent with the zip code in your lease documents.
- **MJ-08 Local Government Notice Affidavit**
 - Section 1 – Establishment Information:
 - The zip code listed in this section is inconsistent with the zip code in your lease documents.
 - Section 2 – Certifications:
 - Notice to your local government must be provided within ninety days of submitting all application documents and fees. Because more than ninety days passed, it will be necessary to provide your local government and community council with a copy of your corrected Public Notice. Afterwards, complete a new MJ-08.
- **Publisher's Affidavit**
 - Once you have corrected the zip code on the Online Application, it will be necessary to run a corrected advertisement with the correct zip code one time and provide a new affidavit from the publisher. Also include a copy of the corrected ad.
- **MJ-09 Statement of Financial Interest**
 - Page 1, Section 1 – Establishment information for everyone:
 - Please correct the zip code.

It is very important that you submit the above corrections and/or documents in a timely manner so that AMCO staff has adequate time to review the corrections and/or additional documents which must be found to be complete within 90 days of the date of this letter.
