This proposed new marijuana product form is required for a marijuana product manufacturing facility licensee who is seeking Marijuana Control Board (MCB) approval of a new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate for production at its licensed premises, as required under 3 AAC 306.100 and 3 AAC 306.525. **The required \$250 proposed new marijuana product fee may be made by check, cashier's check, or money order.**

This form must be completed and submitted to AMCO's main office prior to production of any new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate. **The proposed new marijuana product may not be produced unless and until the MCB has approved of the product.**

Please note that licensees seeking approval of more than one proposed new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate must submit a separate completed copy of this form and pay a separate fee for each proposed new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate.

<b>Product Description:</b> Details must include the color, shape, and texture.	Cannabis distillate oil is a viscous liquid oil substance, with a density similar to honey, translucent, varying from clear to light honey/green colors.
<b>Ingredients:</b>	Marijuana fiber consisting of flower, leaves and stems obtained from licensed cultivators.
<b>Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:</b>	Marijuana fiber and ethanol pre-chilled to ultra low temperature. Chilled MJ fiber soaked in ethanol, the resulting THC infused ethanol processed through a rotary evaporator, separating the THC oil from the ethanol. The ethanol is recaptured for subsequent use. The crude THC oil is then decarboxylated and then distilled through a short path distillation system, resulting in a high quality and high percentage of THC purity cannabis distillate oil.

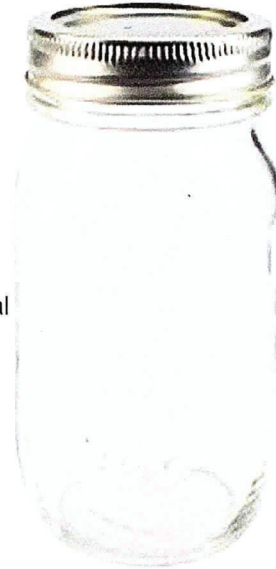

**Packaging Description:**

Details must include the color(s), size, packaging materials used, total amount of THC, individual serving sizes (if multiple), and other specifics showing compliance with 3 AAC 306.565. Please include photos, drawings, or graphic representations.

The concentrated cannabis distillate oil will be stored in clean and sanitized glass mason jars. The weight will vary with each batch of oil extracted and distilled. The total volume of oil and weight in grams of THC will vary with each batch, and each batch will be stored in specific jars because they are unique, and each batch must be entered in METRC, and must be tested before using as an ingredient in edible products. The THC oil measured in grams is calculated with applicable variances before adding to each batch of edible products as an ingredient to insure each individual edible serving contains exactly 5mg of THC cannabis distillate oil.

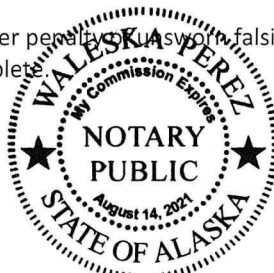
