



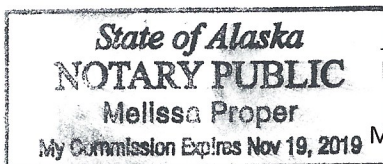

Each lip balm container will contain a maximum of 5mgs of THC, depending on test results per batch, in any event the total mg of THC contained in each unit of lip balms will not be more than 5mgs.

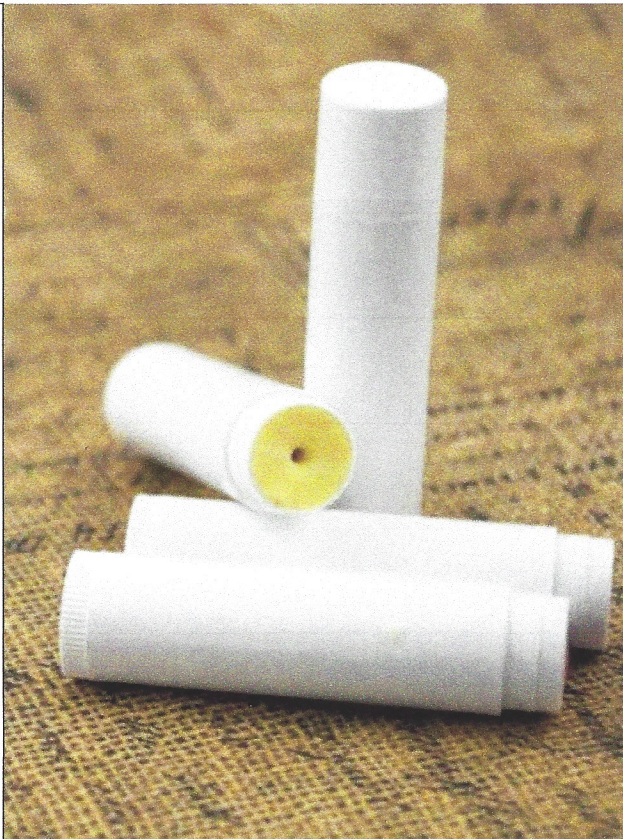
Cannabis wax (contains trace amounts of THC - the cannabis wax is a byproduct left over after the extraction process is complete when creating more potent products like vape pen oil or shatter. The byproduct is a wax that is usually classified by FSE as marijuana waste and destroyed, FSE is turning this wax byproduct into a product to be less wasteful and more resourceful.
Natural Flavoring (Peppermint, cherry, or watermelon essential oil extract), all flavors are not to be combined at once.

Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:

Mix ingredients thoroughly in commercial mixer. Transfer mixture to tubing machine that creates the tubes of lip balm that are inserted in to the twist up lip balm containers. Send to packaging.
