Manufacturing Facility

In April of 2017, the board approved the Raspberry Roots product manufacturing license, along with a product called Canamo Capsules.

The ingredients for Canamo Capsules were: "MCT oil (coconut oil), cannabis concentrate (our own approved concentrate - Sugar Wax, Shatter, crumble, or Delight's oil), **water soluble gelatin and/or vegetarian capsule. Or equivalent thereof**"

Subsequently, the board has been looking more closely at situations where alternate ingredients are proposed, such as "water soluble gelatin and/or vegetarian capsule. Or equivalent thereof." Although this product was already approved with alternate ingredients, I preferred to bring this change to the board rather than give temporary approval.
