

4 chocolate candies will be packaged in a white square box sized about 3" x 3" x 3/4" high. The inner box holding the candies will slide out of an outer wrap-around cover. Labels, described below, will be attached to the top of the box and the bottom. The label on the top of the box will show the main brand marks, product picture, name, etc. The label on the bottom will contain all the regulation warnings, production plant information and ingredients. The box is child-resistant by having two folding tabs that must be pressed against the box allowing the sliding interior box to be pushed out. This forces the purchase to turn the box over; exposing the warnings and information.


