In February of 2019, the board upheld the Municipality of Anchorage's protest of this new license application with a 160-day abeyance, which expired on August, 6 2019.

Due to the expected timeline on the Special Land Use Permit, the licensee is concerned that they will not meet the abeyance deadline. They are requesting an extension of the abeyance period to November 1, 2019.

Dear Director McConnell and Honorable Marijuana Control Board Members:

I am writing on behalf of Shotnine, LLC - license number 15016 to request an extension of the abeyance period from the deadline of August 1, 2019 to November 1, 2019 for the Municipality of Anchorage to lift its protest.

The applicant has not yet received from the assembly an approved Special Land Use Permit for the retail facility. The licensee is currently in the process of completing both the Special Land Use Permit as well as applying for a variance within the MOA specific municipality ordinances.

Once the completed variance and Special Land Use Permit has been submitted to the muni, the next step for Noah is to appear in front of the Anchorage Assembly for the assembly to review and vote to either approve or deny the retail license at hand. Between the time of submitting the SLUP application and time of the Assembly is a 75-day waiting period.

We would like to request an extension date to November 1, 2019 in order to receive approval from the Anchorage Assembly and lift the Municipality of Anchorage protest and obtain the variance. Thank you for your consideration.
