This standard cultivation facility license is held by James W Strassburg. The license is located at 3000 West Tongass Narrows, in Ketchikan. The application was approved by the board on October 28, 2016, and the licensee began operating on January 19, 2017.

During the 2018 renewal period, Mr. Strassburg provided paperwork from the Ketchikan Gateway Borough indicating that the premises address was changed from "2997 Gravina Island" to "3000 West Tongass Narrows." The address was changed in our system.

With each renewal, the licensee is required to submit proof of possession of the premises in order for the board to know that the licensee continues to have sole right to possession of the licensed premises (3 AAC 306.035(b)(2)). When a licensee submits a lease or deed that only provides a legal description of the property, staff requires additional documentation that ties the legal description to the address of the license, such as a tax document.

For the 2019 renewal, Mr. Strassburg submitted a deed and a tax document connecting the legal description on the deed to 2997 Gravina Island, the no-longer-valid address. His renewal documents were submitted in mid-June. An incomplete letter was sent on July 1, requiring the submittal of documents that tied the deed to the current address (3000 West Tongass Narrows). Mr. Strassburg was given seven days to submit the necessary information but did not do so. Thus, a \$1,000 late fee was assessed under 3 AAC 306.100(b).

Mr. Strassburg is appealing the late fee.

AMCO staff has reviewed the renewal documents for the license referenced above. The following items need to be corrected and/or submitted within seven (7) days of the date of this notice or the \$1,000 late fee under 3 AAC 306.100(b) will be assessed.

- **Proof of Possession of Proposed Premises**
  - Documentation will be required that links the physical address of the premises, 3000 West Tongass Narrows, with the address listed on the documents provided, 2997 Gravina Island.
- **Applicant's Alaska Residency**
  - James Strassburg's Alaska residency could not be verified. It will be necessary to work with the Permanent Fund Dividend Division to resolve PFD eligibility for 2019.

It is very important that you submit the above corrections and/or documents as soon as possible. AMCO staff needs adequate time to review the documents and determine if additional corrections and/or documents are necessary to complete your application.

Any marijuana establishment that fails to submit an accurate and complete license renewal application on or before **August 31, 2019** for any reason, including failure to pay any required fees or submit accurate and complete copies of any required supplemental documents, will have its license expire at 12:00 midnight on **August 31, 2019** per 3 AAC 306.035(g).

Please forward this letter to the board members of the Marijuana Control Board  
 letter is an appeal for relief from the \$ 1000.00 fine assessed against my Standard Cultivation license # 10657 by the Marijuana Control Office. Background ; I filed my initial application for a Standard Cultivation license on 6/25/2016 the supplementals I provided to show proof of right to posses were my 2015 Ketchikan Gateway Borough property tax bill and a registered Quit Claim Deed with my name and the legal description of the property I own and the Cultivation Facility sits on. I also provided the GPS location and the physical address assigned by the borough. I filed subsequent renewals using the same documents for evidence of ownership. In July of 2018 the borough changed the addresses on the island I live on. My address was changed from 2997 so Gravina island to 3300 West Tongass Narrows Ketchikan I notified the Marijuana Control Office of the changes and supplied a letter from the borough planner dated 6/12/2018 and Marked exhibit B. It speaks to the address change and the header contains the legal description, the parcel number the old address and the new address I also supplied an aerial photo showing the changes exhibit C. The Marijuana Control Office made the required changes to the record. On July 17 2019 I filed for a license renewal again, again I used my borough property tax statement with my name and the borough parcel number on it and my registered Deed with my name and the legal description of my property to show the right to possession I left for Washington state on June 30 for a vacation and see my doctor.. On July 1 I received a e-mail from the MCO saying my application was incomplete, that the documents I sent to prove the right to posses were "Insufficient". They said I had 7 days to get more info to them or be fined \$1000.00 for having a incomplete application, the deadline was July 8, they basically gave me two days to come up with something as the fourth of July was Thursday and then the weekend and the eighth of July was the following Monday I have enclosed the e-mails where I told them of my previous experiences and the dilemma I was in being out of state. On July 8th I e-mailed Erica McConnel and asked for her to give me an extension on the deadline to produce the as yet unidentified and probably non-existent documents. She never responded to my request On July 20 I returned to Ketchikan and got out the file from the address change, I sent the exact same letter from the borough planner about the address change and a new property tax bill and got back an e-mail stating my application was now complete except for the \$ 1000.00 fine so I paid it and now I am appealing to the Marijuana Control Board for relief from this arbitrary fine leveled against my license # 10657 on the following grounds

#1 The application was complete when it was received by the Marijuana Control Office on July 17. To evidence this claim I offer Exhibit A, this is a communication from the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office Re; Marijuana Establishment License Renewal Application Notice, It clearly shows that proof of right to possession can be verified by [ current lease/title/deed] forth box from the top

#2 The July 8 deadline was arbitrary and flawed it did not allow for the holiday and weekend therefor it was only two days

#3 The letter from the borough planner about the address change was already on file in July 2018 with the MCO and it tied the new address to the deed I supplied, through the legal description To sum up, nothing in this application renewal process has been disrespected by me, I have used the same documents to prove my ownership since my initial application in 2016 and they were always accepted by the MCO until this year, I have enclosed the chain of e-mails between myself and the MCO that show my willingness to cooperate with them and certainly nothing in my actions justify a \$1000.00 fine be assessed against my license Thank you for your thoughtful consideration

**Notes:** The address assigned above is for the buildings permitted by Zoning Permit 6201 and 2939. At the time of issuance, only one of the buildings was given an address. This address has been changed to correct the location and numbering convention.

Under KGB Code 12.10, you are required to affix the numbers assigned in such a manner that they are visible from the road off which the number is issued. This requirement facilitates emergency responders in locating your property. Numbers shall be not less than three (3) inches in height and can be made of either metallic or nonmetallic material. If the building or structure cannot be seen from the road, the number shall be placed at the primary entrance road or drive as well as on the building or structure permitted. In the event the address assigned replaces an old address, you are also required to remove any old numbers that are affixed to the entrance, or elsewhere on such house, building or structure which may be confused with the number assigned. Removal of the old numbers must be done within thirty (30) days of this notice. The builder and/or owner shall be responsible for providing and installing address numbers on new or units under construction.

The Planning Department makes it a practice to notify the City of Ketchikan of the new address; however, you may still be required to provide the city or KPU with a copy of this notice and the accompanying Zoning Permit when obtaining services. It is also your responsibility to notify the Post Office, your lending institution, utility provider, and other interested parties of the new address.





Good morning. My name is James Strassburg. I am having an issue about proof of ownership of the property where I reside and have my standard cultivation facility. When I applied for my license I sent you a deed and the tax bill from the borough as proof. It was acceptable and I was issued a license 10657. When I renewed my license in the subsequent years I submitted the same deed and a borough tax bill for the previous year in Ketchikan the tax bill comes out in July so I have had to use the previous years bill. The deed uses legal description to identify the property the tax bill uses an account number. In the past I asked the borough clerk for documents that would tie ownership to the street address and was told none existed. Last year the address was changed by the borough and AMCO was notified and the license address was changed accordingly without problems. It seems this year the same documents are not satisfactory. I was notified on July 1 that I had 7 days to come up with some information that would tie my property to the address 3000 west Tongass Narrows or my license would be assessed with a \$1000.00 fine. I have not grown or sold any Marijuana in a year. I have been in the hospital 3 times in the last 18 months for heart surgery and I am out of state until the 20 of July. If you would please give me an extension to try and get some additional documentation that I have already been told by the borough clerk doesn't exist. It would help me to figure out how to comply and not be fined. I have owned my property for over 30 years. I've been a Alaska resident since 1973. 

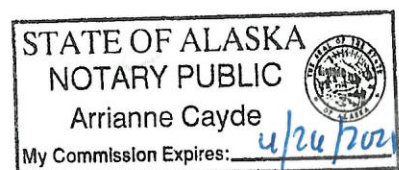
