Members of the Board,

This subject as hand is the issue, the scope, and/or the oversight by the Marijuana Board as it pertains to edible THC infused treats for animals, specifically dog treats, as first proposed by Cosmic Seaweed in April of 2020 in their MJ-16 application.

Statute(s) and Regulations:

Sec.17.38.020. Personal use of marijuana.

- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the following acts, **by persons 21 years of age or older**, are lawful and are not criminal or civil offenses under Alaska law or the law of any political subdivision of Alaska or bases for seizure or forfeiture of assets under Alaska law:
- (1) possessing, using, displaying, purchasing, or transporting marijuana accessories or one ounce or less of marijuana;
- (4) consumption of marijuana, except that nothing in this chapter permits the consumption of marijuana in public; and
- (5) assisting, aiding, or supporting another person who is 21 years of age or older in any of the acts described in (1) (4) of this section.

3 AAC 306.990. Definitions

(27) "marijuana infused product"(A) means a product that contains marijuana or marijuana concentrate and is **intended for human use**;

Additional Information:

A review by AMCO staff regarding other state regulatory marijuana boards shows:

- California Does not address oversight responsibilities of THC for animals
- Massachusetts Does not address oversight responsibilities of THC for animals
- Washington The Washington State Attorney General communicated that the State of Washington does not allow cannabis in dog treats.
- Oregon specifically prohibits a retail store from selling animal food, treats, or other pet or animal products containing hemp or marijuana. The issue of manufacturing products for animals is not currently addressed under Oregon's manufacturing section.

Additionally, I requested Mr. David Schade and Mr. Robert Carter from CED and DNR add to their presentation today items from their training and experience as it pertains to marijuana and CBD laden animal edibles.

I am presenting the proposition that the Marijuana Control Board does not have statutorily standing to regulate animal products in any form only human consumption.

Additionally, I am recommending the board consider either taking no action or commence with a motion against the March 18, 2020 MJ-16 application as it specifically pertains to "ChillPill Canine Cookies."

Reference: Cosmic Seaweed (LLC #19728) MJ-16 Request

At the April MCB meeting licensee Cosmic Seaweed requested approval of an MJ-16: Proposed New Marijuana Product. The Product requested for approval by the board was for a product "Chill Pill Canine Cookies" specifically designed for consumption by dogs/canines. The board asked the Alcohol and Marijuana Office (AMCO) to look in to the unusual situation and to reconsider the application at the June MCB meeting.

Further investigation has revealed that the oversight for such food products are under the purview of the State of Alaska Department of Agriculture. Additionally, the SOA Department of Agriculture is currently in process to publish regulations of such products.

It is the recommended by the AMCO that the MCB board not approve the MJ-16 since the board does not have jurisdiction or regulatory authority over the creation and consumption of edible items for animals.

This proposed new marijuana product form is required for a marijuana product manufacturing facility licensee who is seeking Marijuana Control Board (MCB) approval of a new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate for production at its licensed premises, as required under 3 AAC 306.100 and 3 AAC 306.525. The required \$250 proposed new marijuana product fee may be made by check, cashier's check, or money order.

This form must be completed and submitted to AMCO's main office <u>prior to production</u> of any new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate. **The proposed new marijuana product may not be produced unless and until the MCB has approved of the product**.

Please note that licensees seeking approval of more than one proposed new marijuana product or marijuana concentrate must submit a separate completed copy of this form and pay a separate fee for <u>each proposed new</u> <u>marijuana product or marijuana concentrate</u>.

Ingredients:	Wheat flour, eggs, canned pumpkin, peanut butter, Medium Chain Triglyceride oil, salt, cinnamon, cannabis oil for edibles.
Standard Production Procedure and Detailed Manufacturing Process:	Medium chain Triglyceride Oil and cannabis oil will be warmed and blended with an immersion blender until homogeneous. Other ingredients will be mixed together using a counter top kitchen mixer and the oil mixture will be blended in until homogeneous. Resulting dough will be rolled out to 1/2" thick, cut out into dog bone shapes using a cooki cutter mold. Then placed on parchment paper and baked at 350 for 40 minutes úntil hard. Product will be sent for required testing, packaged and placed in storage untíl testing complete, then sold to retailers.
