Regarding drive throughs in a separate building, does the board want a regulation project? There is a discussion on the subject. Bruce S. motions open a regulation project to clarify that drive thrus should be part of contiguous space. Ely C. seconds. None opposed, motion passes. Is there a motion to reconsider the variety packs? No. Nick thanks staff.

Director Wilson asks for a 4-hour discussion regarding the 3 AAC 306 rewrite at the January 2024 meeting if there is not a full agenda. The board agrees.
