On 07/01/24 Municipality of Anchorage Land Use Enforcement notified AMCO that Red Run Cannabis Company (Lic# 11411, retail marijuana store, transfer pending) was operating without functional surveillance cameras in the retail sales area.

On 07/10/24, Investigators Murray and Bankowski conducted an inspection of the premises. Upon reviewing the surveillance cameras it was confirmed that only the cameras covering the outside of the premises and interior storage areas were accessible. Manager John Pratt confirmed that no one within the company was able to log in and access the retail sales area cameras and they have not been able to do so since at least March 1st, 2024 when Red Run took over management of the business. The recording DVR/NVR appeared to be powered on but it is unknown whether or not the cameras have been recording during this time.

Pratt said that Red Run Cannabis owner Marc Theiler installed one Wyze web-based camera in the retail area as an interim solution. Pratt showed me the live stream from the camera and it showed only a portion of the restricted access area and point-of-sale area. He also said the camera is not capable of recording for the minimum 40 days. Pratt said that after the visit from Land Use Enforcement they have been actively working with Long Security to restore access to the cameras.

As of 07/30/24, access has still not been restored. A proposed solution with the hardware manufacturer is currently being deployed and should be completed soon.

At no point was AMCO ever notified of this deficiency by the licensee or Red Run Cannabis Company, whom the license is being transferred to.

I looked for Inv Linger's transaction on the system and found it on cameras 7 and 8 at the point of sale and it also appeared in Metrc. I recorded it with my phone. I found an additional transaction the same day that appeared to be made by James Gladle for three ounces which was also found in the Metrc Sales Transactions. I also recorded this transaction with my phone.

On 07/09/2024 at approx. 1015 hours, Investigator Linger was conducting a routine inspection at Dreaming Tree on S Viki Way, located in Wasilla. Investigator Linger used a scanning device to verify the facility inventory, which had been downloaded that morning, 07/09/2024 at approximately 0800 hours. Investigator Linger found multiple discrepancies between what METRC downloaded to the scanner and what was in the facility. Mother/Veg room 1 – should have 55 plant tags, none were found due to all plants being moved to room three several days prior, and not reported in METRC. Actual count of plants in Mother/ Veg room 1 was 222 tagged plants not reported in METRC. Flower Room 2 – should have 84 plant tags, with only 64 present and 20 missing due to a harvest which had not been reported in METRC. Flower Room 3 – should have 110 plant tags and none were located due to a harvest that was not reported in METRC. The plant tags that were in room 3 should still be in room 1 according to METRC. Investigator Linger spoke to Jennings Sturgeon who stated METRC had not been updated in approximately one month. Jennings stated he was out of the country on vacation, and he's the only one that updates METRC for the business. 407 total violations of 3 AAC 306.410 (1)(2), and 3 AAC 306.435(a); 203.5 each respectively.

3 AAC 306.435 Marijuana inventory tracking system (a), A marijuana cultivation facility shall use a marijuana inventory tracking system in compliance with 3 AAC 306.730 to ensure all marijuana propagated, grown, or cultivated on the marijuana cultivation facility's premises is identified and tracked from the time the marijuana is propagated through transfer to another licensed marijuana establishment, including when marijuana or marijuana product is relocated to the new licensed premises in the case of a transfer of a marijuana establishment license to another location approved by the board, or destruction. This is a notice to you as a licensee that you are being issued a notice of violation for the purposes described in 3 AAC 306.806(e). A description of the violation is as follows,

NOTE: This is not an accusation or criminal complaint.

On 07/31/2024 AMCO Investigator Joe Linger entered your facility to conduct a routine inspection. Investigator Linger requested to see the marijuana handler permits of each person working inside the facility that day. One person, later identified as Daniel Clemons, stated he didn't have his on him. He was given an opportunity to present it before the inspection ended. Clemons left the facility and didn't return. I received an email later that day that included a screenshot of both Clemons person of interest background check, and his certificate of completion of the Alaska Marijuana Handler Permit Training Course dated 07/31/2024. Checking on Clemons original handler permit revealed it to have expired on 08/14/2022. Clemons was seen in the AMCO office on the morning of 08/01/2024 getting his new marijuana handler permit. During the time his handler permit was expired he worked at your limited cultivation helping harvest and trim on three dates, 03/28/2024, 04/22/2024, and 08/14/2024. This is in violation of 3AAC 306.700(a)(d) Marijuana Handler Permit. This is in violation x3 each of the referenced Administrative code.

3 AAC 306.700. Marijuana handler permit

- (a) Each agent of the marijuana establishment who sells, cultivates, manufactures, tests, or transports marijuana or a marijuana product, or who checks the identification of a consumer or visitor, and each licensee and employee must obtain a marijuana handler permit from the board before being licensed or beginning employment at a marijuana establishment.

This is a notice to you as a licensee that you are being issued a notice of violation for the purposes described in 3 AAC 306.806(e). A description of the violation is as follows,

NOTE: This is not an accusation or criminal complaint.

On July 12/2024 Investigator Linger was conducting routine follow up on a complaint regarding High Society Laboratory, License #29879. The complaint stated there had been an explosion in May 2024 and a fire in June 2024 at High Society Laboratory located at 6514 N Farm Loop Rd Bldg #2, in Palmer. The complaint also stated there was product removed from the licensed premise. Inv. Linger went to the location and spoke to Travis Webb, the son of licensee Robert Webb, who stated there was an explosion of their equipment in May which the fire department responded to. Webb stated there was also a fire in June that the fire department responded too. I inspected the facility and saw the entire inside of the building covered in black soot consistent with a fire, as well as an area next to a small chest freezer that had extensive fire damage to the floor which could be seen through. When asked why the incidents were never reported Webb didn't know. I photographed the building inside and out. Webb stated the two partners, Kristerfer Byers and Lacey Rego, took product and equipment from the building (license #29879) and moved it to Byers unaffiliated licensed location and was producing and selling from there (license #13659).

I went to 11740 E Weathervane Circle Shop, in Palmer (License #13659, which is a Limited Marijuana Cultivation owned by Kristerfer "Kris" Byers). Byers stated he had product from the other location and wanted to return it to the licensee's it belonged to. Byers stated it was in a locked secure location, and when asked to see it he stated it wasn't actually locked up. Byers was cooperative and honest about the product and took me into his home (not part of the licensed facility) and showed me the product sitting unsecured on the dinning room table (i took a photo of the product). Byers stated the product didn't have a manifest when it was removed from the original facility to his home in June 2024, just after the fire. I asked how he intended to return it without a manifest and he stated he was trying to figure out what to do. Kris stated approximately 220 gr of product had already been returned to Bad Grammer, and 175 gr to Hatcher Grass. I checked with Bad Grammer and Hatcher Grass, both had manifests created in METRC that were dated on July 12, 2024, in which the product was moved from his home (11740 E Weathervane Cir Shop, Palmer, AK), not the licensed facility which is the address on the manifest, 6514 N. Farm Loop Rd. Bldg. #2, Palmer, AK). Both manifests were falsified showing the product coming from one location, the licensed facility, when it in fact came from a different location which is not a licensed facility. The remainder of the product has been secured inside the licensed premise #13659 at my direction until a determination can be made what to do with it. This is in violation of the below referenced Administrative Codes.

This message is a response to the NOV issued in AMCO Case # AM-24-1570.

As explained in the NOV, our concentrate manufacturing facility (Lic. # 29879) sustained an explosion in May 2024 and a fire in June 2024. The May explosion caused some damage and stress, and led to additional expenses, but we were able to continue operating. The result of the fire was more severe, and the facility was no longer operational. After the fire we struggled with how to regroup and proceed following such a disaster.

As further noted in the NOV, the facility was covered in soot and there was extensive fire damage. Consequently, almost all of the marijuana plant material and concentrate located in the facility was destroyed or damaged to the point that it was not usable. The only inventory that survived was approximately 675 grams of concentrate that was already earmarked to be delivered to Bad Grammer (220g) and Hatcher Grass (175g) pursuant to previous agreements. Of that 675g total, 395 grams was packaged for resale at the licensed premises before the fire and was kept in a small refrigerator, which is how it survived the fire. We did not have enough packaging material to package the remaining 280 grams, so it was stored in the oven while we waited for a delivery of packaging material, and it remained in there during the fire, so it was not affected.

After the fire the prepackaged 395 grams of product and the other 280 grams was transferred to Kris Byers' home, which is not a licensed facility, for storage while we contemplated our next steps. After that, the 395 grams that was pre-packaged for resale was later transported to Bad Grammer and Hatcher Grass. The remaining 280 grams was intended to be sent to Bad Grammer once we received additional packaging materials. That 280g is currently under administrative hold.

We were shaken up and made poor decisions in the aftermath of the fire. We acknowledge that the transfer of the 675 grams of marijuana concentrate from the damaged licensed facility to Mr. Byers' home, and the transfer of the 395 grams from his home to Bad Grammer and Hatcher Grass, did not comply with AMCO regulations regarding the tracking, storage, and transportation of marijuana concentrate. Our only excuse is that this was a stressful and very difficult time, we were under duress, and made poor decisions. We should have contacted AMCO for guidance immediately upon realizing that the facility was not operational and that the surviving inventory would need to be transferred. However, there was no intent to violate the regulations or divert product, and all of the inventory that was removed from the facility is accounted for, as we were holding it in order to eventually transfer it to Bad Grammer, pursuant to its pre-existing agreement. We regret the decisions we made and now recognize these serious errors.

Due to the circumstances involved, and because this is the first NOV received for this license, we request that no further action be taken with respect to this NOV. We further request that the product at issue remain on administrative hold status until the facility is operational again, at which time the hold would be released so that we could transfer the remaining product back to the facility. We would then resubmit it for testing before transferring it to a retail store.

We appreciate your consideration of this request.
