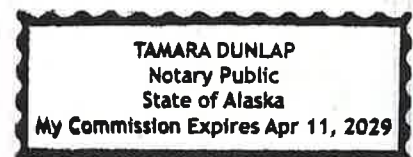

RE: Response to Notice of Violation

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing in response to the Notice of Violation regarding the burglary incident that occurred at our Northway facility on or about March 22, 2026, and the subsequent sales transaction involving employee Levi Coman.

First, I would like to acknowledge that after reviewing 3 AAC 306.715(e), I understand that the burglary should have been reported to AMCO within the required timeframe regardless of the fact that the product was voluntarily returned shortly after the incident. My decision at the time was based on my understanding that because all products had been returned before the 24-hour reporting window elapsed, and because the situation appeared resolved without loss or diversion, reporting was not required. I now recognize that interpretation was incorrect.

Over the course of approximately eight years operating multiple licensed marijuana establishments in Alaska, we have experienced several prior break-ins and have consistently reported those incidents appropriately. This is the only occasion in which we failed to do so. The circumstances surrounding this incident were unique due to the fact that the individual involved returned the product voluntarily the following morning and admitted responsibility.

Northway is a small rural community, and my decision was influenced by an attempt to handle the matter locally after the individual involved acknowledged his actions, returned the property, and appeared remorseful. At no point was there any intent to conceal diversion, avoid regulatory oversight, or disregard compliance obligations. In hindsight, I understand that the regulations required reporting regardless of the recovery of the product or the surrounding circumstances.

Regarding the alleged sales limit violation, our staff are trained and regularly reminded regarding Alaska's retail marijuana sales limits and compliance requirements. We take those limits seriously. After internal review of the transaction involving Levi Coman, he is being relieved of his position with the store. We are also conducting additional internal compliance reviews and retraining procedures to ensure future adherence to all sales limitations and reporting requirements.

We remain committed to operating in compliance with Alaska regulations and maintaining cooperative communication with AMCO. We respectfully ask that AMCO consider our longstanding compliance history, the voluntary recovery of the products, the absence of ongoing loss or diversion, and our corrective actions in evaluating this matter.

Dear Licensee:

After reviewing your renewal documents, AMCO staff has deemed the application complete for the purposes of 3 AAC 306.035(c).

Your application will now be sent electronically, in its entirety, to your local government, your community council (if your proposed premises is in Anchorage or certain locations in the Mat-Su Borough), and to any non-profit agencies who have requested notification of applications. The local government has 60 days to protest your application per 3 AAC 306.060.

At the May 15, 2017 Marijuana Control Board meeting, the board delegated to AMCO Director the authority to approve renewal applications. However, the board is required to consider this application independently if you have been issued any notices of violation for this license, if your local government protests this application, or if a public objection to this application is received within 30 days of this notice under 3 AAC 306.065.

If AMCO staff determines that your application requires independent board consideration for any reason, you will be sent an email notification regarding your mandatory board appearance. Upon final approval, your 2026/2027 license will be provided to you during your annual inspection. If our office determines that an inspection is not necessary, the license will be mailed to you at the mailing address on file for your establishment.

Dear Local Government:

AMCO has received a complete renewal application and/or endorsement renewal application for a marijuana establishment within your jurisdiction. This notice is required under 3 AAC 306.035(c)(2). Application documents will be sent to you separately via ZendTo.

To protest the approval of this application pursuant to 3 AAC 306.060, you must furnish the director **and** the applicant with a clear and concise written statement of reasons for the protest within 60 days of the date of this notice, and provide AMCO proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

3 AAC 306.060 states that the board will uphold a local government protest and deny an application for a marijuana establishment license unless the board finds that a protest by a local government is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable. If the protest is a “conditional protest” as defined in 3 AAC 306.060(d)(2) and the application otherwise meets all the criteria set forth by the regulations, the Marijuana Control Board may approve the license renewal, but require the applicant to show to the board’s satisfaction that the requirements of the local government have been met before the director issues the license.

At the May 15, 2017, Marijuana Control Board meeting, the board delegated to AMCO Director the authority to approve renewal applications with no protests, objections, or notices of violation. However, if a timely protest or objection is filed for this application, or if any notices of violation have been issued for this license, the board will consider the application. In those situations, a temporary license will be issued pending board consideration.
