



**ALCOHOL AND MARIJUANA CONTROL OFFICE ADVISORY NOTICE:
Acceptance of DMV Mobile Identification as Proof of Age**

Advisory

The Alaska Department of Motor Vehicles, through the DMV Mobile ID Verifier, provides a mobile identification card (mID). This mID is a digital representation of the information contained in a physical identification card or a driver's license. By downloading the Alaska mID app, one can verify, identify, and display their ID when necessary to prove age or identity. The mID is intended to complement, not replace, a physical ID.

During the September 2025 meetings of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and Marijuana Control Board, each board discussed the use of Alaska Mobile IDs issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles as proof of age verification.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board approved the DMV Mobile ID as an identification card that satisfies the proof-of-age requirement under AS 04.21.050(b).

The Marijuana Control Board approved the DMV Mobile ID as an identification card that satisfies the proof-of-age requirement under 3 AAC 306.350(b)(3).

This does not require an alcohol or marijuana licensee to accept the DMV mID as proof of age. A physical or hard-copy identification card is required to be carried along with the DMV mID and may be requested by a licensee to verify proof of age.

At this time, only State of Alaska ID's are accepted under this advisory notice. Out-of-state ID's or other identification methods will need to be physically verified.
