**ADVISORY EXPIRED ALASKA DRIVERS
LICENSES- UPDATE**

To: All alcohol and marijuana licensees
Reference: **ADVISORY:** Updated Acceptance of Expired 2020 Alaska
Operating Licenses during the Health Emergency Mandates

As the Health Mandates from the Governor's office yesterday were extended, the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office again reviewed the statutes suspended for the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) under AS 28.15.101(a) Driver license expiration. We are interpreting this suspension of the Alaska Operating Licenses (OL) statute as meaning alcohol and marijuana establishments may use State of Alaska OL's which have expired during 2020 to identify Alaskans and determine if they meet the requirements for alcohol and marijuana services. This shall be a valid form of verification until the Governor's suspension of AS 28.15.101(a) is rescinded and will remain so until the expiration of the disaster declaration.
