COVID-Safe Travel Promotion and Marketing Grant Program Launch

Friday, April 30, 2021 (Anchorage, AK) – The Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED) Division of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA) is pleased to announce the launch of the COVID-Safe Travel Promotion and Marketing Grant Program. DCCED invites nonprofit entities engaged in tourism marketing and promotion to apply no later than 4:30 p.m. on Monday, May 10, 2021.

“Promoting travel is essential to the state’s economy,” **said Julie Anderson, DCCED Commissioner.** “The COVID-Safe Travel Promotion and Marketing Grant Program is an exciting opportunity for our nonprofits to get the funds they need to make a huge difference for their community, its businesses, and the state’s economy as a whole.”

This is a competitive, multi-award grant opportunity for the rapid-deployment of marketing campaigns promoting Alaska as a COVID-safe travel destination for the Summer of 2021. Promotions may be marketed toward in-state travelers as well as independent travelers in national and international markets.

Four levels of grants will be awarded, ranging from \$100,000-\$3,000,000, with a total of \$10 million available.

Qualifying nonprofits should submit proposals to promote Alaska as a COVID-safe travel destination, encourage Alaskans to get out and explore the State, and increase awareness of vaccine availability in national and international independent travel markets.
