To All Accredited Reinsurers Approved in the State of Alaska:

Re: Instructions for 2021 Annual Statement Filing Requirement and Fee Payment

As an accredited reinsurer, it is necessary that you file annual statements by March 1 of each year as required under Alaska Statute (AS) 21.12.020(a)(2)(C). You also need to file the Form AR-1, Certificate of Assuming Reinsurer by March 1, 2022, to the Alaska Division of Insurance.

The Alaska Division of Insurance is accepting the electronic filing with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) to meet the filing requirement for an annual financial statement in Alaska Statute (AS) 21.09.200 for accredited reinsurers. No paper annual statement should be sent to the Alaska Division of Insurance for foreign reinsurers. All alien reinsurers should send the hard copy annual statement to:

A filing fee of \$100 will be required and must be postmarked to the address in the letterhead by March 1, 2022. Or, new this year is the ability to pay the \$100 by credit card. Failure to file and pay would be considered a violation of statute and grounds for removal of the accredited status.
