To All Automobile Service Corporations Admitted in the State of Alaska:

Re: Instructions for 2024 Financial Statement Filing, Annual Premium Tax Report, and Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee Payments

A checklist is available listing all the required filing requirements and due dates at our website <https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/ins/Insurers.aspx> then Annual Filing and Taxes. If the company contacts or service of process have changed, at the same website under Amendments are the respective contact forms to file.

- A. A financial statement showing the automobile service corporation's financial condition, transactions, and affairs for the preceding December 31, with a verification signed by two officers, must be postmarked by March 1, 2025.
- B. An audited financial statement is due to the Alaska Division of Insurance postmarked by June 1, 2025. This statement can be filed by March 1, 2025, in lieu of the statement described in A, or per Alaska Statute (AS) 21.09.200(e) the corporation shall pay to the Division of Insurance \$100 for each day the corporation fails to file and may be suspended from entering into new obligations or issuing new policies of insurance in Alaska.

- Alaska requires the corporation file the Annual Premium Tax Report and pay the Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee through OPTins by March 1, 2025. See [Regulatory Order R 17-05](#). The bond requirements and financial statements may be filed via OPTins as well.
