To All Foreign Companies Admitted in the State of Alaska:

Re: Instructions for 2021 Annual Statement Filing, Annual Premium Tax Reports, and Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee Payments

The Alaska Division of Insurance is accepting the electronic filing with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) to meet the filing requirement for an annual financial statement in Alaska Statute (AS) 21.09.200 for all foreign admitted insurers. No paper annual statement should be sent to the Alaska Division of Insurance. If the annual statement is not received by March 1, 2022, at the NAIC, a late fee of \$100/day will be assessed.

A checklist is available listing all the required filing requirements and due dates at our website <https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/ins/Insurers.aspx> then > Annual Filing and Taxes. If the company contacts or service of process have changed, at the same website under Amendments are the respective contact forms to file.

- Alaska requires the company file the Annual Premium Tax Report and pay the Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee through OPT*ins* by March 1, 2022. See [Regulatory Order R 17-05](#).
