Re: Instructions for the 2021 Annual Statement Filing, Annual Premium Tax Reports and Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee Payments

The annual statement and supplements are due to the Alaska Division of Insurance on or before March 1, 2022. The Alaska Division of Insurance will not mail the annual statement. It is available at our web site <https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/ins/Insurers.aspx> then Annual Filing and Taxes. A checklist is available at the same location listing all the required filing requirements and due dates. If the company contacts or service of process have changed, at the same website under Amendments are the respective contact forms to file.

If the annual statement is not postmarked by March 1, 2022, a late fee of \$100/day will be assessed.

- Alaska requires the company file the Annual Premium Tax Report and pay the Annual Premium Tax and Continuation of Certificate of Authority Fee through *OPTins* by March 1, 2022. See [Regulatory Order R 17-05](#).
